AUPHA's Global Healthcare Management Symposium 2022

Call for Proposals

The Global Healthcare Management (GHM) Faculty Forum of the Association of University Programs in Health Administration (AUPHA) invites you to submit competitive proposals for the Global Healthcare Management Symposium, which is scheduled the first day of the 2022 AUPHA Annual Meeting on June 7, 2022. The Annual Meeting schedule is still being finalized – please watch for details in future communications from AUPHA.

The Global Healthcare Management Symposium is designed to:

- Link participants with shared interests in Global Healthcare Management & Policy
- Share best practices in quality global health management education
- Further partnership opportunities for faculty to enhance their teaching, service, and research (both globally and in the US)
- Explore ideas to address challenges, multi-national approaches, and innovative channels to advance global health management (both globally and in the US)

The theme of this year's 2022 AUPHA Annual Meeting is "The Evolution of Normality: Embracing Shifting Boundaries." This is a great opportunity to focus on the experiences of AUPHA members and their global healthcare management education partners in working together to find new, innovative means to transform the future of healthcare and the healthcare management educational process. The Global Healthcare Management Symposium is following the Annual Meeting's established sub-themes: (1) Resilience and Agility; (2) Innovation and Creativity; and (3) Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, Belonging & Social Justice, at the student, faculty, and field levels.

Global Collaborative Focus:

A primary goal of the GHM Faculty Forum is to create international connections that link AUPHA with similar associations of healthcare management programs in multiple countries and regions of the world. Representatives and/or members of these associations are particularly encouraged to submit proposals. Preference will be given to proposals that include collaborations between U.S. faculty and colleagues from other countries, and for collaborations with members of other AUPHA Faculty Forums (see list of faculty forums here: <https://www.aupha.org/faculty>)

Session Types:

Submissions may be for Individual Presentations/Posters or Panel Presentations. Submissions should align with the AUPHA sub-themes, and international partnerships between faculty (and students) is highly encouraged.

- **Panel Presentations:** Proposals are designed for a group of presenters that would like to conduct a 30-minute panel style session.
- **Individual Presentations/Posters:** Proposals are designed for individuals who would like to conduct a 20-minute presentation. Note that these submissions may also be considered for a panel or poster presentation by the GHM Faculty Forum reviewers.

Guidelines:

Submissions should focus on experiences that will serve to catalyze discussion. The focus should be on actual experiences in different countries working with healthcare management educational programs that engage communities and partner organizations in promoting innovation or transformation among students, global partnerships, or health systems. Presentations on case studies or analyses of national/global trends that impact health are also encouraged.

Proposals must include:

1. Name, organizational affiliation, and contact information of any presenter(s)
 - It is understood that changes may occur. The presenters identified (or any last-minute substitutes), however, must attend and register for the full AUPHA Annual Meeting.
 - Panel Presentations may include up to three participants, but presentation time is still limited to 30 minutes per session (2/3 presentation/panel and 1/3 discussion and conclusions).
2. Proposal title (15 words or less)
3. An abstract of the presentation that include session description, learning objectives, session relevance, and format or style of session (300 words or less)
4. Session type
5. Whether the proposal (or a version of it) was also submitted to the general AUPHA Annual Meeting.

Review and Submission Portal

Proposals will be selected based on commonality of focus and fidelity to the program theme/sub-themes. Each submission will be peer reviewed and given full consideration by the GHM Symposium Planning Committee.
