2017 AUPHA Global Healthcare Symposium
*Theme: Maximizing Health Management & Policy Education through
Inclusion and Innovation*
Tuesday, June 13, 2017 | Long Beach, CA,
preceding AUPHA Annual Meeting June 14-16, 2017

The Global Healthcare Management network of the Association of University Programs in Health Administration (AUPHA) invites you to submit competitive proposals for a pre-conference symposium on Global Healthcare Management Education, held in conjunction with the AUPHA 2017 Annual Meeting.

This one-day Global Healthcare Symposium, preceding the annual conference is designed to:

- link participants with shared interests in Global Healthcare Management & Policy;
- further partnerships and to provide a succinct review of opportunities for faculty to enhance their teaching (both overseas and in the US), service, and research, and
- explore ideas for multi-national approaches / innovative channels and techniques in global classrooms...through small group discussions, plenary and panel talks, & fast but impactful exercises.

The theme of this year's Annual Meeting is "Maximizing Health Management and Policy Education through Inclusion and Innovation". This is a great opportunity to focus on the experience of AUPHA members and their global healthcare management education partners in working together to identify and include communities and health professionals in the healthcare management educational process.

What would be a great submission for the Global Healthcare Management Symposium?

A primary goal of AUPHA and the Global Healthcare Management network is to create international connections that link AUPHA with similar associations of health care management programs in other countries and regions of the world. Representatives and/or members of these associations are particularly encouraged to submit proposals.

- Presentations dealing with approaches to creating sustainable partnerships are strongly encouraged, as we feel this addresses the topic specifically around "inclusion and innovation" related to global healthcare management.
- Presentations dealing with the issues of collaboration in building partnerships between academic programs and provider and/or payer organizations internationally that benefit faculty in their teaching and research in each of the global partner programs.
- We are particularly interested in presentations that discuss partnerships in global health management education between US (North American) universities and international programs.
- Based on real experience with partners that have resulted in innovative approaches to community health needs, inclusion of NGOs and community organizations in the healthcare management education process or partnerships that have influenced national or local health policies.



SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Submissions should focus on experiences to share that will serve to catalyze discussion. **Short workshop format is preferred with presentation and small group discussion and reporting in 30 or 60 minute blocks.** The focus should be on actual experience in different countries working with healthcare management educational programs that engage communities and partner organizations in innovative approaches to improve healthcare management. A well-structured exercise that leads to transferrable understanding of partnership management is preferred.

Presentation of case studies or analyses of national trends that impact health are encouraged. However, any individual presentation in this area should be based on personal experience in country which could include research. Individual presentations should not be longer than 10 to 15 minutes in length and will be selected based on commonality of focus and fidelity to program theme. The rest of the session must include time for structured group activities designed to identify lessons learned and use of such case studies in healthcare management programs globally – not just the US. Focus is on the global experience and US-based cases or research will not be considered.

Submission should include the following:

1. Name, organizational affiliation and contact information of workshop leader (who will be the panel moderator) for partnership presentations or themed panel presentations
2. Proposal title (15 words or less)
3. Names and organizational affiliates of panel members; it is understood that changes may occur. However, the team identified (or any last minute substitutes) should attend and register for the Global Healthcare Management & Policy Symposium
4. Proposals may include up to 4 participants (but presentation time is still limited to 10 to 15 minutes per session (1/3 presentation to set up 2/3 discussion/workshop and conclusions time). “Presenters” may present in the first 1/3 or work on stirring or debriefing the discussion.
5. Abstract of Presentation
 - a. Should include: Length of session (30 or 60 minutes); session learning objectives, description of program, format of presentations and description of a small group exercise.
 - b. Abstract is limited to 250 words or less.
6. Each proposal will be peer reviewed and given full consideration by the GHM Symposium Planning Committee
7. All proposals must be submitted via email to yriesman@ucla.edu with a subject line: “**2017 AUPHA Global Healthcare Symposium Proposal**” All email submissions will be acknowledged upon receipt.
8. The submission deadline is Monday, February 20, 2017.
