## Stephanie Stuckey

CEO, Stuckey's  
Corporate Board Member, Bealls

Stephanie Stuckey is CEO of Stuckey's, known for generations as a highway oasis serving up pecan log rolls and kitschy souvenirs. Founded in 1937 by her grandfather, W.S. Stuckey, Sr. in Eastman, Georgia, Stuckey's grew into over 350 stores nationwide by its peak in the 1970's. The company was sold in 1964 and sadly declined for decades under a series of corporate owners. Fortunately, Stuckey's returned to the family in 1985 under the leadership of W.S. Bill Stuckey, JR. and is now being continued with Bill's daughter, Stephanie.

The Company acquired a pecan shelling and candy plant in Wrens, GA in January of 2021 and have been scaling production of the Stuckey's branded snacks and sweets – including the iconic pecan log roll – to be sold in almost 5,000 retail stores nationwide. Stuckey's also operates a distribution center in Eastman, GA, a fundraising business, a corporate gift program, and has an online store.

Stephanie received both her undergraduate and law degrees from the University of Georgia. She worked as a trial lawyer, was elected to seven terms as a state representative, ran an environmental law firm, served as Director of Sustainability for Atlanta, and taught as an Adjunct Professor at the University of Georgia School of Law. Stephanie purchased Stuckey's in November of 2019 and assumed the role of CEO. Stephanie's achievements include being named one of the Most Admired CEOs of 2022 by the Atlanta Business Chronicle, 100 Most Influential Georgians by Georgia Trend Magazine and a graduate of Leadership Atlanta. She serves on the corporate board for Bealls, a Florida-based retailer with more than 550 stores.

The Stuckey's story has been featured recently in the New York Times Sunday Business Section, the TODAY Show, and The Washington Post.

When she's not running Stuckey's, Stephanie enjoys traveling by car to explore the back roads of America and pulling over at every boiled peanut stand and the World's Largest Ball of Twine.



The Beta Gamma Sigma Entrepreneurial Achievement Award formerly called the Medallion for Entrepreneurship Award provides national recognition to those individuals who develop, organize, and enhance successful new ventures. Recipients of this signature honor have assumed the risk of starting a business or initiating a new venture/idea within a larger organization. The intent is to focus on our entrepreneurs as the people who drive innovation, our economic engine, and support for new ideas.

Beta Gamma Sigma Chapters are eligible to nominate entrepreneurs based on the following criteria:

- Entrepreneurs who develop, organize, and launch a successful business venture or social entrepreneurship endeavor that has demonstrated success and proven through its operational results to be a sustainable concept
- Exemplars for ethical business leadership and the values of the Beta Gamma Sigma Society, including honor and integrity, and the pursuit of wisdom, earnestness, and service are sought

A nominee need not have received a degree in business or be a member of Beta Gamma Sigma to receive this award.



## Daniel Lubetzky

Founder, KIND Snacks

*Nominated by Trinity University*

Best known as the founder of KIND Snacks, Daniel Lubetzky is a business leader, investor, and social entrepreneur working to build bridges between people and increase appreciation for our shared humanity. As the son of a Holocaust survivor, he has made it his life's work to help prevent what happened to his father from happening again.

Daniel's foray into food was the unexpected outcome of his work to use business to bring neighbors in Middle Eastern conflict regions together. He conceived nonprofits OneVoice, Empatico, and Starts with Us to foster empathy and empower individuals to practice daily habits that move our culture away from extreme, divisive, and hateful positions.

Through his startup investment and incubation platform Equilibra Ventures, Daniel partners with promising entrepreneurs building innovative enterprises with integrity. A proud Mexican-American, he co-founded SOMOS, a brand on a mission to bring food from the heart of Mexico to American kitchens.

Daniel is a member of the Anti-Defamation League's Inaugural Board of Directors. He has received awards from The King Center (Salute to Greatness Humanitarian Award), World Economic Forum, the Skoll Foundation, Conscious Capitalism, the Hispanic Heritage Foundation, and the Horatio Alger Association for his commitment to create economically sustainable and socially impactful businesses. Daniel was named a Presidential Ambassador for Global Entrepreneurship by President Obama.

Daniel holds a BA in Economics and International Relations from Trinity University and a JD from Stanford Law School. He is a proud US citizen who emigrated from Mexico at age sixteen.



## Mike Jenkins

Co-Founder, 'Elevating Aotearoa's Future'

*Nominated by Auckland University of Technology*

Mike Jenkins is a fast-paced entrepreneur, leaping from one successful venture to another. With an exemplary career establishing multiple start-ups in the technology industry, shaping businesses for future succession and showcasing home-grown kiwi innovation.

Mike is the co-founder of 'Elevating Aotearoa's Future', fostering indigenous Māori and Pacific peoples into the technology sector, bringing forth Waikato as the hub of the technology sector and opening doors of opportunities in regional New Zealand. His latest tech investment is one of the most diverse technology companies in Asia Pacific with 70% of female employees and 30% indigenous Māori or Pasifika - in an industry that struggles to break the 5% threshold of both indigenous employees and women.

Mike launched his career in the tech industry in 2004 as a business analyst for Computerland New Zealand (which subsequently was acquired by Spark). He steadfastly climbed the ladder with IBM, Cisco Systems and was the founder and CEO of The Instillery which he has recently handed the reins off. Mike is most passionate about community and its people, a proven track record of building purpose led teams, developing new leaders, commercialising digital and tech businesses, and executing for success in the toughest economic climate.

Mike has achieved numerous industry, business and leadership awards; Rising Star in 2014 at the CIO awards, Winner of the Management Excellence award 2017 ARN Innovation Awards, voted 13th in the 50 most influential CIOs in New Zealand in 2018 and recognised as the 2021 Aotearoa NZ CEO of the year at the Waikato Westpac Business Awards. Mike truly embodies the values of Beta Gamma Sigma, of continuous service with honour and integrity by being a mentor to young leaders in the technology industry. Auckland University of Technology's Business School is proud to have a visionary alumnus making impact with principle.

## Lindsay Boyle

Chief of Staff of Advanced Surgical  
Instruments, Medtronic

*Nominated by Metropolitan State  
University of Denver*

Lindsay Boyle has been with Medtronic since 2006. Joining as a contractor, she quickly moved to full-time in operations accounts management, soon ascending through 8 positions over 10 years – from services delivery specialist to Director. After achieving her MBA in 2020 from MSU Denver, she spent two years as Senior Director of Global Operations and Supply Chain Quality Excellence and Strategy before being promoted in late 2022 to Chief of Staff of Advanced Surgical Instruments. Here, she works to address pressing business needs and provide support in implementing key strategic initiatives. At Medtronic, she is a catalyst for change and leadership – which is indicated by her current pursuit of an Ed.D. in organizational leadership and change. At Medtronic, her teams have completed work contributing to organizational transformation, improving product quality, patient outcomes, and the lowering costs/eliminating waste in the organization. Lindsay is passionate about Medtronic's patients and strives to create lasting cultural change that puts patients first wherever she has an opportunity to serve.

For the MSU Denver community, Mrs. Boyle shares her story of inspiration, innovation, and leadership. In the past year, she has presented to campus stakeholders of management and entrepreneurship regarding sustainability efforts, as well as sharing her professional leadership journey as a panelist for the MSU Denver MBA "Women in Business" webinar event.

Lindsay is based in Boulder, Colorado, and lives with her husband, John, of 17 years, and three kids, McKenna (14), Cooper (11), and Beckett (7), and one Portuguese Water Dog, Sydney (2). She is a mountain bike instructor, avid snowboarder, loves fly fishing and trail running. Lindsay holds a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Colorado, Boulder, an MBA in Strategic Leadership from Metropolitan State University, Denver, and is a Doctoral candidate in Organizational Change and Leadership at the University of Southern California.



## **Kevin E. Lofton, LFACHE**

CEO Emeritus, CommonSpirit Health

*Nominated by Georgia State University*

Kevin E. Lofton, LFACHE, CEO Emeritus of CommonSpirit Health (CSH), is one of the most influential and longest-standing leaders in the healthcare industry. He retired on June 30, 2020 after serving for 21 years as CEO with Catholic Health Initiatives (CHI), now CommonSpirit Health, a system of hospitals and other care centers in 21 states. Under Lofton's leadership, CHI transformed from a hospital company to an innovative, diversified healthcare entity. In 2019, CHI merged with Dignity Health to form the \$29 billion non-profit healthcare entity, CommonSpirit Health with Mr. Lofton as CEO.

Throughout his career, Mr. Lofton had a broad impact across the sector by helping to increase the ranks of healthcare executives and physicians from underrepresented groups and reduce care disparities in underserved populations. He is a former president of NAHSE and was a founding board member of the Institute for Diversity, as well as a board member of the Morehouse School of Medicine and the Heersink School of Medicine at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. In addition, Kevin was the founding chair of the American Hospital Association's (AHA) Equity of Care Initiative, which was later joined by the Catholic Health Association, the American Association of Medical Colleges, and America's Essential Hospitals.

Mr. Lofton has received numerous accolades for his accomplishments. He has been included in Modern Healthcare Magazine's list of the "100 Most Influential People in Healthcare" 15 times. In addition, he received the Distinguished Alumni award from Georgia State University, the AHA's Distinguished Service Award, an honorary doctorate in Humanities in Medicine from Baylor College of Medicine, the ACHE Gold Medal Award, the NAHSE Hall of Fame Award and the Pierre Toussaint Medallion from the Archdiocese of New York. Currently, Mr. Lofton serves as Lead Independent Director on the board of Gilead Sciences, Inc., on the Medtronic, plc board, and is the Vice Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Georgia State University Foundation.

## Enrique Ramírez R. Ph.D.

Dean, School of Business and Economics, Universidad ICESI

Enrique Ramirez Robledo has extensive experience in managing educational programs, teaching and leading cross-cultural academic activities in different countries. He teaches Global Strategy, International Business and Innovation at ICESI and at international universities such as: Tulane, ESAN, Montpellier and U. de Chile.

Dean Ramirez Robledo is a member of the CLADEA Steering Committee and the AACSB Latin American Council. Previous working positions include commercial experience in the banking sector and the design of development projects for NGOs. He has written several teaching cases indexed in Harvard Business Publishing and his research has focused on intercultural competence.

Dean Ramirez Robledo has been fundamental in the development of the Universidad ICESI BGS chapter, that was recognized as the winner of Beta Gamma Sigma's 2023 Silver Outstanding Chapter Award. He has motivated the group to be increasingly united to generate more projects that make the Icesi BGS Chapter internationally renowned. For example, he has been a key player in supporting the design of the LIFS Challenge, which is the main academic activity that the Icesi BGS chapter does annually. It is based on four fundamental pillars (Leadership, Innovation, Finance and Strategy) and groups of students from recognized universities solve real business problems that are presented by well-known organizations.

Finally, students as well as former BGS members recognized the role of Dean Ramirez Robledo in forging bonds of friendship and commitment among BGS members, while trying to make each member a leader who has a positive impact and takes ownership of their responsibilities.
