



## 2018 Scholarship Program (Revised 6/5/2018)

### Scholarship Description:

A \$5,000 Scholarship will be awarded directly to the recipient which is to be used to defray expenses associated with obtaining an undergraduate or graduate degree in a field that will lead to a productive career in the corporate / commercial real estate industry. The Chapter also will pay for a one-year student membership to CoreNet Global. The Awardee will also be publicly acknowledged and presented the Award at the CoreNet Global Atlanta Chapter Education Forum, on Thursday, August 16th, 2018.

### Requirements:

- All applicants must be accepted or enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university geographically located in the State of Georgia, or a Georgia resident who is studying in an accredited school located in another state, and must be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree related to corporate / commercial real estate (the "Qualified Program").

- All undergraduate applicants must be a rising junior or above.

- Scholarship funds are to be used for expenses, including tuition, room and board, textbooks and materials, and any other expenses related to achieving a degree in the Qualified Program. The Awardee will be required to sign a statement to this effect.

- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be considered for the Award.

*Official transcripts will be required prior to final confirmation of the Award.*

**Applicants who are chosen as Finalists will be advised by email by Friday, July 6 and must be available for a personal interview on the afternoon of July 25 in Atlanta (Buckhead area). In certain circumstances, interview participation via Skype is possible.**

**The chosen Scholarship Awardee is expected to attend the Chapter's Education Forum on Thursday, August 16 in Atlanta (Perimeter area).**

### Selection Criteria:

The selection of scholarship recipients will be determined by a committee made up of members of the Atlanta Chapter of CoreNet Global, with consideration of the following criteria:

- The applicant's indication of interest in pursuing a career in corporate/ commercial real estate.
- The applicant's record of scholastic achievement to date, including academic grade point average and extracurricular activities.
- The applicant's community service and internship/employment experience.
- The applicant's financial needs.
- The applicant's recommendations by two people familiar with the applicant's achievements or goals. These would include professors, counselors, employers, colleagues, CoreNet Global members, and other individuals.

The application must be completed, **including the recommendations**, and submitted electronically to the Atlanta Chapter's designated contact point **no later than 5:00 pm EDT, Friday, June 15, 2018**. Please be sure to mark all support materials and pages with the name of the applicant for whom the materials are being submitted.
