Hotel Initiatives

- Strong recycling culture of paper, plastic, and glass from all areas of the hotel. Recycling receptacles are located in guestrooms and public areas.
- Power Smart Committee implements energy saving measures such as turning off escalators when not needed.
- All guestrooms feature low flow showers and public restrooms feature motion sensor taps to help conserve water.
- Electronic thermostats in every guestroom provide accurate and constant temperature control.
- Installed Energy Star Rated televisions in all guestrooms.
- Voluntary towel and sheet reuse programs allows the guest to choose how often they would like linens refreshed.
- Discarded linens, towels, shampoos, soaps, etc. are donated to shelters in the city.
- Electronic chemical control systems that optimize chemical consumption.
- Programmable laundry equipment that optimizes operating times reducing energy costs and damage to linens and towels.
- In the kitchen, oil is recycled. Leftover foods that are able to be donated are provided to various shelters/charities while perishables like fruits and vegetables are composted.
- Seasonal menus, drawing the best locally sourced ingredients.
- Banquet displays and serving vessels are residential in style and replenished frequently offering guests fresh food while minimizing waste.

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
