

IAAP Membership Classifications

There are four classifications for IAAP membership:

A **Professional Member** is employed as an administrative professional. In addition, anyone who attained the CPS or CAP rating is an instructor of business education, or an office manager may be a Professional Member.

A **Professional-Merited Member** has been a Professional Member for ten years at time of retirement, has reached the age of 55, or was forced to retire because of physical disability.

A **Student Member** is enrolled in a business education program and can be classified as a Student Member for a maximum of four (4) years.

An **Associate Member** is an individual, firm, or educational institution, which sustains the objectives of IAAP.

Membership in IAAP provides a voice to promote a rewarding and cooperative relationship with employees, to represent member interest to media, government, business, industry, and the educational community. Members have access to the largest pool of professional information available and insight into changing office trends, directions, and requirements.
