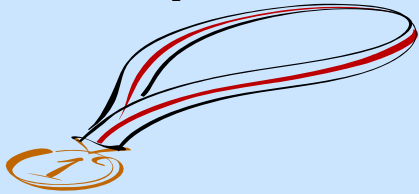
Last month of school!!!

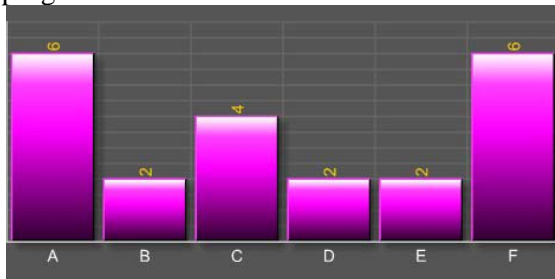

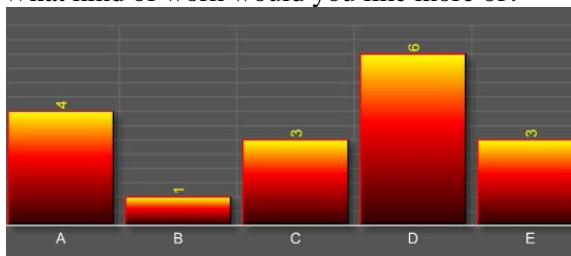

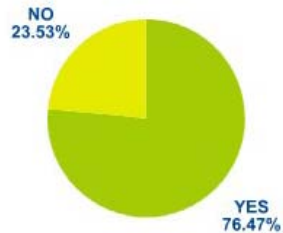

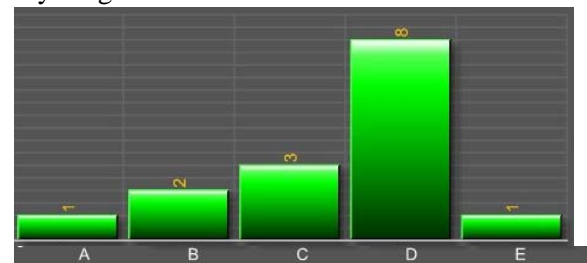
