From Jacksonville: (Estimated distance about 97 miles – 1 hour 35 minutes)

Take **I-95 South** to **Exit 256**, SR-421, towards Port Orange/Daytona Beach Shores. Turn **left** onto **SR-421 E/Taylor Road**. Continue to follow SR-421 E, Dunlawton Avenue, towards Port Orange Hospital. Turn **left** onto **Woodbriar Trail** (Chili's Grill & Bar is on the right. If you have reached S. Nova Road, you have gone 0.3 miles too far). Make a U-turn onto Woodbriar Trail. 3800 Woodbriar Trl. is on the **right**.

From Cocoa Beach: (Estimated distance about 68 miles – 1 hour and 10 minutes)

Take **I-95 North** towards Daytona Beach. Take the **SR-421 exit, Exit 256**, toward Port Orange Hospital. Turn **right** at the end of the exit onto SR-421 (Dunlawton Avenue). Continue to follow SR-421 E. / Dunlawton Avenue. Turn **left** onto Woodbriar Trail. (Chili's Grill & Bar is on the right. If you have reached S. Nova Road, you have gone 0.3 miles too far) Make a U-turn onto Woodbriar Trail, 3800 Woodbriar Trail is on the **right**.

From Ocala: (Estimated distance about 80 miles – 1 hour 35 minutes)

From either US-27 / US-301 / US-441 / SR-25 / SR-500 / toward W. Silver Springs Blvd / SR-40 E. Continue to follow **SR-40 E**, Merge onto **I-95 South to Exit 256**, SR-421, towards Port Orange/Daytona Beach Shores. Turn **left** onto **SR-421 E/Taylor Road**. Continue to follow SR-421 E, Dunlawton Avenue, towards Port Orange Hospital. Turn **left** onto **Woodbriar Trail** (Chili's Grill & Bar is on the right. If you have reached S. Nova Road, you have gone 0.3 miles too far). Make a U-turn onto Woodbriar Trail. 3800 Woodbriar Trl. is on the **right**.

From Gainesville: (Estimated distance about 106 miles – 2 Hours and 10 minutes)

From **SR-20 E** continue about 42.5 miles turn **slight left** onto **S 9th St. / SR-20**. Turn **right** onto **Reid St** / US-17 / SR-20 / SR-15 / SR-100. Continue to follow US-17 S / SR-20 E / SR-15 S / SR-100 E. (US-17 S is just past St. Johns Ave. if you reach Main Street, you've gone a little too far) Turn **left** onto **SR-20 / SR-100**. Continue to follow SR-100 (SR-100 is just past Dotney Ave. If you reach Crosby Rd. you've gone a little too far). Turn **left** onto **N. State St / US-1 S / SR-100 E**. Continue to follow US_1 S. Merge onto **I-95 S** via the ramp on the left toward Miami. Take the **SR-421 exit, Exit 256**, toward Port Orange Hospital. Turn **left** at the end of the exit onto SR-421 (Dunlawton Avenue). Continue to follow SR-421 E. / Dunlawton Avenue. Turn **left** onto Woodbriar Trail. (Chili's Grill & Bar is on the right. If you have reached S. Nova Road, you have gone 0.3 miles too far) Make a U-turn onto Woodbriar Trail, 3800 Woodbriar Trail is on the **right**.
