2000-01 Indiana Division theme: ***Reach for the Stars and Find a Galaxy of Opportunities***

Leadership Conference

- Hosted by Lafayette Chapter and held on June 24 at the Holiday Inn
- Treasurer utilized Monopoly game to provide information in a fun way
- Sessions included chapter development sessions -- membership, chapter meetings, "funraising", public relations and marketing, and Microsoft Office User Specialist certification

Annual Meeting and Education Forum

- Hosted by Evansville Chapter - ***Excellence ... Excitement ... Enthusiasm ... Evansville!***
- Open House featured "make your own" ice cream sundae, chapter vendor tables, and games
- The banquet entertainment featured the Silent Singers who performed a ballet of the hands to a musical arrangement entitled "What America Means".
- Benefit Breakfast proceeds went to the Research and Education Foundation
- An amendment to the Indiana Division Bylaws and Standing Rules to combine the office of Recording Secretary and Corresponding Secretary was adopted.
- Chapter contest renamed to the Multi-Media Communications Award and chapters were encouraged to develop electronic newsletters and points were awarded for web site updates. Winners included Belles Lettres Chapter (up to 35 members) and River Bend Chapter (over 35 members)
- An Attendance Award was presented to the chapter with the highest percentage of chapter members attending annual meeting having full and

- partial registrations -- '500' Chapter with 42%
- Saturday afternoon seminar featured Shari Peace - *How to Keep Your Attitude Up No Matter What Gets You Down*

The Indiana Division web site was redesigned and managed by Trista Niesen of Keller Crescent in Evansville. Chapter links were offered at no charge and a template was created to provide a more consistent look to each page.

The Membership Committee continued the Indiana Division Scoreboard.

2001-2002 Indiana Division theme: ***Think Believe Dream Dare***

Leadership Conference

- Hosted by Rose City Chapter and held in August
- The theme of the event was Camp IAAP
 - Merit badges were handed out at the conclusion of each presentation
 - Had a fishing pond and trees -- chapter pictures were taken and displayed on Division web site
 - All presentations titles centered around the camp theme
 - Presentations given using PowerPoint slide show
 - Treasurer material was presented by playing Who Wants to be a Millionaire?
 - Presentations included information on the Indiana Division web site, publicity, certification, chapter programs, and fundraising

Annual Meeting and Education Forum

- Hosted by River Bend Chapter and held at the University of Notre Dame - ***Indiana Division's Fabulous Fifty Years!***
- Meeting will spotlight the Indiana Division's 50 years
 - Indiana Division history booklets available
 - Slide show during Open House to be on display featuring pictures from the past 50 years
 - Chapters encouraged to create poster for display at Open House reflecting their history
- Registration material was accessible on the Indiana Division web site

Division committees were assigned to chapters to encourage that more members become involved on the Division level. Chapters were asked to assign one person as the contact person.

The responsibility of the Indiana Division web site was switched to an IAAP member (Diana Nickler CPS - Belles Lettres) to ensure updates are made more frequently and encourage return visits to the site. Changes to the web site included a photo album page (featuring photos from board contact visits, international convention, leadership conference, and holiday greetings from the Board), monthly survey, daily quote of the day, hit counter, special events page (featuring IAAP events such as Annual Meeting and Great Lakes District Conference), etc.

Chapter contest changed to Outstanding Chapter Contest with points being awarded for roster book, chapter brochure, chapter bulletin/newsletter, and updates to chapter web site.

The members of the Indiana Division were entered on a spreadsheet allowing the board to send out mailings more often to specific groups and the student members were added in order that they be included in all mailings.

The Indiana Division Board Letter format was changed to an electronic format in order that it could be available to all members. Chapter presidents were notified of its availability on the Indiana Division web site and encouraged to notify their members. Letters were sent to members at large asking them to provide email addresses or to request a hard copy of the Board Letter. Financial statements and Division board minutes were converted to a pdf file and emailed to chapter presidents to share with their members.

Impact meetings were held in Bloomington and Franklin College for potential new chapters as well as at Lilly for a possible corporate chapter.

2002-2003 Indiana Division theme: ***Grow Personally, Grow Professionally, Grow by Participating***

Leadership Conference

- Hosted by Athens of the Prairie Chapter and held on August 24 at Cinergy Offices in Columbus
- The theme of the event was Sherwood Forest IAAP Style
 - Officers took on the Robin Hood characters – Robin Hood (President), Little John (Vice President), Maid Marian (Secretary)
 - Treasurer material was presented with chapter treasurers testing their bow and arrow skills by hitting a target; questions were then asked relating to the treasurer position
 - Presentations included information on the Indiana Division web site (Diana Nickler CPS – '500'), intergenerational issues, humor, certification (Cathy Mathews CPS – '500'), recruitment and retention (Division Officers), and fundraising (Pat Cichos – River Bend)
 - Two outside speakers, Billie Goodner of Columbus Regional Hospital (intergenerational issues) and Susan Blizzard of IUPUI (humor), were featured.
 - Several students and the advisor from the Student Chapter in Indianapolis attended the conference.
 - Chapters were encouraged to consider maintaining their own chapter web sites.

Annual Meeting and Education Forum

- Hosted by the “500” Chapter and held at the Adams Mark Hotel
Old Friends - New Dreams

- Open House featured The Electric Catfish, games and chapter/vendor tables, plus the slipper contest.
- Keynote and seminar speaker was Dr. Suzanne Metzger
- Banquet featured Andy Childs

Division Treasurer, Renata Addison resigned and Nadine Boyd of River Bend Chapter stepped up.

Belles Lettres Chapter of Elkhart disbanded The Hillenbrand Industries Chapter opened its membership to the local community and changed its name to the Southeastern Indiana Chapter. A chapter in Franklin has committed to charter in the fall of 2003.

A new student chapter was formed through the efforts of Linda Foley of Rose City Chapter in Richmond, along with Ron Oler, a student advisor at Ivy Tech College.

- Webmaster Diana Nickler CPS/CAP unveiled the Members Only section on the Indiana Division web site. The purpose of the Members Only section is to have an area devoted only to members and includes information such as the Indiana Division Board Letter, Division history, Bylaws and Standing Rules, and other items that should be privy only to members.

2004-2005 Indiana Division theme: ***Hand in Hand, Together We Can***

Leadership Conference

- Hosted by River Bend Chapter and held at the Goodwill Offices in South Bend

Annual Meeting and Education Forum

- Hosted by the Tawasi Chapter and held at the Marriott in Fort Wayne - ***Reach the Summit – Explore, Navigate and Discover IAAP***
- There were 57 total registered for the meeting; 9 chapters were represented.
- Indiana Division sponsored two fundraisers – jewelry was available for sale throughout the weekend and the Board prepared a basket to be raffled off on Sunday morning. Proceeds from the fundraiser went to the Indiana Division General Fund.
- Bylaws approved included the financial report and balance sheet for the

Division will be published on a quarterly basis beginning at the end of the first quarter and will be available on the Members Only section of the Indiana Division web site. It was also approved that the Annual Meeting minutes will be available in the Members Only section as well and no hard copies will be printed.

- Chapter Anniversaries: Evansville – 60 years, Maple – 50 years and Indy Northside – 25 years.
- Chapters with 100% retention included '500', River Bend and Verizon chapters.
- To increase monthly readership of the Indiana Division Board Letter, the Board had a "Hand in Hand" contest. Members were encouraged to count the number of hands each month. The winner of the CD player was Melinda Burton of Athens of the Prairie Chapter.
- The newly established Award of Excellence of presented. The 2005 award was presented to Metalworking Machinery Systems, Inc. of Elkhart.

Highlights for the year included:

- There was a loss of three chapters but there was a gain in student chapters.
- The Board also had a monthly chapter participation contest in designated categories and President Biller donated prizes. (Participation included: Largest percentage of members attending September meeting, largest RTF contribution, sponsor of a new student chapter, etc.

2005-2006 Indiana Division theme: ***Orchestrating Excellence***

Leadership Conference

- Hosted by '500' Chapter and held on Saturday, August 27 at the Indianapolis Marriott, Eastside.

Annual Meeting and Education Forum

- Hosted by Past Indiana Division Officers and held at The Seasons Lodge and Conference Center in Nashville, Indiana – ***Relax ~ Refresh ~ Renew.***
- As no chapters were willing to host, the Annual Meeting was made up a committee of past Indiana Division officers spearheaded by Sally Biller (2003-2005 President) and Pam Waggoner (2001-2002 President).
- Committees were structured differently than they have been done in years past. Committees included Hospitality (Ann Boeke – 1996-1997 President), Printed Materials (Diana Nickler CPS/CAP – 1998-2000 President), and Registration (Lauretta Schrock – 1987-1988 Secretary and Denise Goveia – 2004-2005 Secretary). Athens of the Prairie Chapter was also instrumental in assisting with speaker suggestions and open house vendors.
- There were 59 members in attendance; 8 chapters were represented.
- The Bylaws and Standing Rules Committee report was given at the Sunday morning business session rather than on Saturday.
- Chapter presidents and division officers were recognized at the banquet rather than at the Recognition Luncheon.

- The amendment to the bylaws recommending that Leadership Conference be incorporated into the Indiana Division Annual Meeting and Education Forum (as of 2007) was adopted.
- Great representation of students from the student chapters in attendance.
- The Symphony Contest award (to increase monthly readership of the Indiana Division Board Letter) encouraged members to count the number of musically-themed clipart throughout the newsletter each month. The winner was Melinda Burton of Athens of the Prairie Chapter.
- The 2006 Award of Excellence was presented to First State Bank of Middlebury and Eli Lilly Company in Indianapolis.
- Proceeds from the Benefit Breakfast (\$500) were added to the seed money for the Division scholarship.

Highlights for the year included:

- The Division was incorporated this year.
- The Indiana Division Resource manual was created and placed on the Members Only section of the Indiana Division web site.
- The Board held a Strategic Planning Meeting in February with Chapter presidents and vice presidents/president-elects. International President, Kay Enlow CPS/CAP served as facilitator for the meeting.
- Indiana Division waived Division dues this year for student memberships.
- Verizon Summit City Chapter (Fort Wayne) disbanded at the start of the year.
- Membership certificates are now issued to members when they renew their membership.
- Increase of 45.61% in student membership.
- Net membership gain through April 30 of 17 members – 5% increase.
