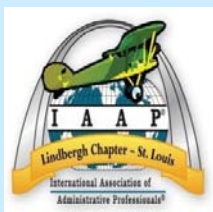
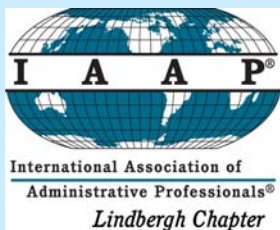

licorice, gumdrops, jelly beans

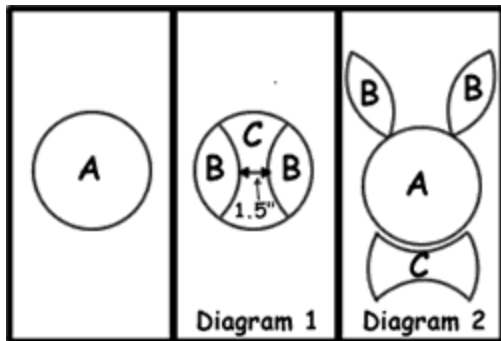
MAKE IT!
