As we prepare for our final meeting of our fiscal year, let's reflect on this past year.

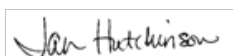

Please mark your calendar now for May 20-22, 2011 for the "Up Scale-Down Home" PA Division Meeting!

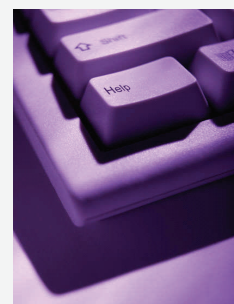
