Everyone is Important – You are a Key Person

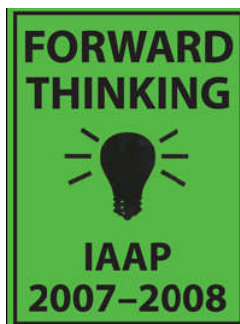

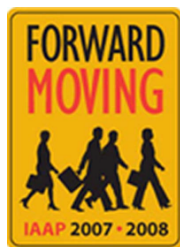
