- A. The means by which processed data is made available for human use.
- B. Makes information available to users.
- C. Measurement of the actual viewing screen diagonally from corner to corner.
- D. Number of pixels that make up the image on the screen and the dot pitch of the monitor.
- E. The more used, the clearer and crisper the image.
- F. Distance between the centers of the adjacent pixels. The lower this is, the greater number of pixels and the higher the resolution.
- G. Device that strikes the paper through the ribbon and leaves an impression of the characters.
- H. Images are created on the page through either ink-jet or laser imaging processes.
- I. Fast-drying electronically charged ink to spray ink droplets through an electronic field to form the images.
- J. Low-power light beam capable of simultaneously carrying millions of characters.
- K. Needed for large drawings. Moves the paper past a stylus bi-directionally.
