In the Roanoke area, she serves on the boards of United Way of the Roanoke Valley and The Business Council, as well as the Community Advisory Board of the Junior League of Roanoke Valley, and the Advisory Board for Wachovia Bank. She is also a consulting trustee with Opera Roanoke.

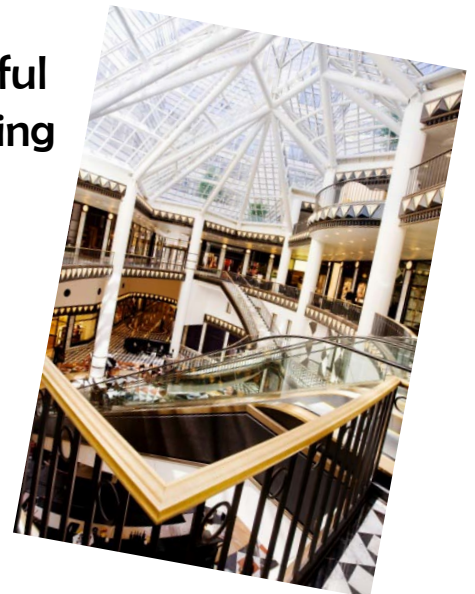
