Certification News:

Changes to the IAAP Certification Program

Effective November 2011



Don't forget:, All active CPS ratings have now changed to CAP, and all active CAP ratings have changed to CAP with the Organizational Management specialty, CAP-OM. Active ratings include individuals who have recertified as required every five years. In the case of CPS holders who certified prior to January 1988, your rating is considered active and will be changed. Your certification status has nothing to do with your status as an active member of IAAP.

For candidates who tested in November 2011, any appropriate changes to your records will be made automatically after exam results are available in December.

Any proposed Bylaw Amendments for 2011-2012 must be submitted no later than February 1, 2012.

New Business:

ECD Executive Board passed the following Motion: That the 2012 Eastern Canada Board (ECD) approves the name change of Ontario Division to Central Canada Division (CCD). Furthermore, that the boundaries of the newly established CCD be realigned to include the western shore of the St. Lawrence River.

Background:

At the November IAAP International Board meeting in Kansas City, International Director – Canada District Director Veglia proposed to have the Ontario Division name changed to Central Canada Division (CCD) with a boundary change to include Montreal, PQ. The International Board was in agreement with this change. With this change, CCD will change their boundaries to include Montreal (the western shore of the St. Lawrence River), so that the Ottawa Chapter can sponsor a chapter in Montreal. By supporting this change, it would provide a future Montreal Chapter to be geographically closer to their sponsor chapter and provide them with the much needed presence when forming a new chapter – e.g. in-person visit, ability to travel to host chapter within a 2-hour span as opposed to a 10-hour span to Moncton.
