### About the speaker:



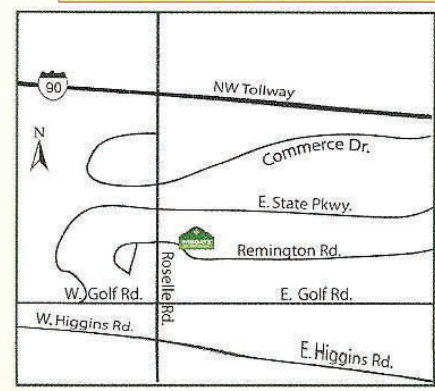
