WHAT IT TAKES TO BE A LEAGUE THEATRE MEMBER

Theatre Membership Dues

(based on Theatre's Total Annual Expenses - for multiple venues, total combined annual expenses of all theatres)

LEVEL 1: Total annual expenses of \$5M+

LEVEL 2: Total annual expenses of \$3M-5M

LEVEL 3: Total annual expenses of \$1M-\$3M

LEVEL 4: Total annual expenses of \$300K-\$1M

LEVEL 5: Total annual expenses of <\$300K

LEVEL 6: "Emerging" theatre, not yet operating

*The League defines theatre members as historic theatres built 50+ years ago. Historic registry designation is **not** required.*
