



My Bar Access is the only online member-to-member community exclusive to Massachusetts Bar Association members.

My Bar Access offers each association section or division with an opportunity to interact and exchange information through **member groups**. In addition to member-created content, the **member groups** provide information on section-sponsored MBA On Demand programs, *Section Review* articles, section leadership and more.

The Role of Group Administrators

Group Administrators (Group Admins) play a vital role in the management of their section/division's member-generated content. Group Admin functions include:

- Adding member group **announcements** and useful links;
- Encouraging fellow group members to post **blogs**, **discussions** or **resource library** files; and
- Modifying **tags** within member groups.

Announcements: **Announcements** are established for each section's **member group**. ONLY Group Admins can post in the announcements section.

Blogs: Similar to **discussions**, **blogs** are an interactive option, allowing **My Bar Access** users to provide information to their **member group**.

Discussions: **Discussions**, formerly known as listservs, are the ideal communication tool within **member groups**. **Discussions** provide a resource for **My Bar Access** users to instantly connect with each other via web-enriched e-mail messaging.

Resource Library: The **resource libraries** allow **My Bar Access** users to share files in a secure, online environment. All attachments to **discussions** posts are automatically included in the **resource library**. Group Admins perform core management roles within the library including: library file editing and deletion, reassigning library entries and organizing the library folder view.

Tags: Tags are labels applied to **resource library** entries or **blog** posts to ease identification and recall. Tags are currently available per section and a post's content type. Similar **tags** are organized into tag groups managed by Group Admins. Group Admins can modify all **tags** within the **member group** they manage, while members can only access/modify **tags** to content they created. Group Admins are responsible for creating **tags** requested by **My Bar Access** users.
