## 2012 Awards Criteria

**Member of the Year Award:** This award is given to an exceptional member of the Indiana Chapter who through volunteer efforts has made outstanding grassroots contributions and demonstrated unparalleled commitment to the advancement of the chapter.

**Pinnacle Award:** This is IMPI's *Most Prestigious Award* and it will honor a planner or a supplier who has developed and delivered an event more successful than any other in the past year. The recipient will represent a model of planning excellence.

**Planner/Supplier Award:** An IMPI member (one planner and one supplier) who has consistently contributed effort, experience and volunteer time to Indiana's meeting industry. Board members are ineligible.

**Young Professional of the Year:** This award recognizes an individual 30 years of age or younger with 5 or less years of professional experience who has made outstanding contributions to the meetings and events industry and to the Indiana Chapter.

**Venue of the Year:** This award recognizes a venue which has held an IMPI event during the last year. As a result of their efforts, it created a memorable IMPI experience enjoyed and appreciated by the attendees.

**Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Meeting of the Year Award:** This award will honor a meeting planner who has demonstrated initiatives showing corporate responsibility in their meetings, conferences and events. Nominees must describe how their business and/or meeting is protecting and enhancing people, profit and the planet in their organizations and communities and results from these efforts if possible.

**Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Venue of the Year Award:** This award is intended to recognize a venue/supplier that has shown a commitment to corporate social responsibility by protecting and enhancing people, profit and the planet in their organizations and communities in the way they manage or do business. Nominees must provide information that showcases specific results from these efforts.

### **Additional awards that may be awarded at the discretion of the IMPI Board:**

**Hall of Fame Award:** This award was introduced to recognize lifetime achievement of one of our chapter members. This individual has demonstrated years of dedication, commitment, and service through volunteerism within our chapter as well as a pledge to the meetings industry.

**Meetings Industry Leadership Award:** An organization that provides consistently high quality meetings and exemplifies the professional impact of excellent communications and meeting execution. Professional organizations eligible include marketing, public relations, event and meeting planners or suppliers in the industry. Membership in IMPI is not required.

**President's Award:** Presented at the discretion of the Indiana Chapter President to the chapter member who contributed significantly to the success of the chapter during the administrative year.
