

**EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW**  
**About our 2018 Chapter Championship to be Held at**  
**Jacaranda Golf Club - West Course**  
**May 20th 2018 1:00 pm Shotgun**



**What is the Chapter Championship?**

The Chapter Championship is one of three annual EWGA national events played on a local level, and is the first stage qualifier of the EWGA Championship. Members of all skill levels are welcome and compete in a one-day tournament of 18-holes of individual stroke play or as a scramble team. The low gross and the low net score of each flight of the stroke play division and the low net scramble team win and advance to the Semi-Finals!

**How does the individual stroke play division work?**

In the individual stroke play division there are five flights with handicaps

broken down as follows:

Championship Flight	0.0 to 10.0
1st Flight	10.1 to 17.0
2nd Flight	17.1 to 24.0
3rd Flight	24.1 to 32.0
4th Flight	32.1 to 40.4

Players are divided into flights and compete with others of similar handicaps. Players with handicap indexes up to 10.0 will play from Tee 4 (5584 yards). All other handicap indexes will play from Tee 5 (5026 yards). The low gross and low net scores of each flight advance to the Semi-Finals.

**How does the scramble division work?**

Scramble teams are comprised of four players. The team handicap (total of all 4 players' "Computation Factors") must fall in the range of +2 to -5. Teams with a total team handicap greater than +2 are not eligible to compete in this tournament. Teams with a handicap of less than -5 may compete but are capped at -5. Only one member of the team may have a handicap index of less than or equal to 10.0. Scramble team members with handicap indexes up to 10.0 will play from Tee 4 (5584 yards). All other scramble team members will play from Tee 5 (5026 yards). The two low net scramble teams will advance to the Semi-Finals.

Handicap Index	Computation Factor
0.0 to 10.0	+2
10.1 to 17.0	+1
17.1 to 24.0	0
24.1 to 32.0	-1
32.1 to 40.4	-2

**Am I qualified to play?**

It's easy to qualify! Players must be a member in good standing of the EWGA Fort Lauderdale Chapter and have a USGA handicap index and the equivalent of at least two 18 hole rounds posted in 2018. It just doesn't get much easier than that!

## What happens if I win the Chapter Championship?

The low net and gross winners of each flight of the stroke play division and the low net scramble team advance to the next level of competition called the Semi-Finals. This year the Semi-Finals will be held at our own

**June 23rd 2018**

The Semi-Finals are the same formats as the Chapter Championship. The low gross and low net score of each flight of the individual stroke play division and the low net scramble team advance to the Finals.

## OMG what happens if I win the Semi-Finals?

Winners of the Semi-Finals will advance to the Finals being played at **Innisbrook Golf Resort in Palm Bay, Florida on October 12th & 13th**. If a player cannot travel to she can always "Decline To Advance" and the runner up will go.



## How much does the Chapter Championship cost?

The cost for this year's Chapter Championship is \$85 - and that includes EVERYTHING!
