NAPNAP Foundation Rural & Underserved Scholarship Qualifications

The NAPNAP Foundation, through funds previously received from McNeil Consumer Healthcare Division of McNeil-PPC, Inc., offers a scholarship up to \$10,000 to a PNP student who plans on practicing in a rural or underserved geographical region for the first two (2) years after he/she completes their PNP education.

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Plan on practicing in a rural or underserved geographical region for the first two (2) years after PNP education completed. After graduation, awardee must submit a description of their practice position that demonstrates they have met the underserved and/or rural criteria. Awardees that do not obtain such employment in an eligible setting after graduation will be expected to repay the school funding they received.
2. Be a registered nurse who has completed at least two 2 semesters or quarters as defined by the university.
3. Documented acceptance at a recognized Master's Degree Program. A Master's Degree Program, for purposes of this scholarship; is defined as one which primarily prepares an individual to deliver child health care services that are ambulatory in nature. The program must be associated with an academic institution authorized to award a master's degree in nursing. The program can be a Master's Program or a Post-Master's PNP Program.
4. Have no previous formal pediatric nurse practitioner education.
5. Demonstrate financial need, based on submission of information regarding resources.
6. State rationale for seeking PNP education that is consistent with NAPNAP's mission statement.

In addition, students must maintain the following:

1. Full-time status (9 or more credit hours/semester) while in PNP program.
2. GPA of 3.0 or higher.
3. NAPNAP membership.
4. Provide NAPNAP with ongoing accounts regarding student status.

Interested students should complete the attached application form. Deadline for receipt of applications is **September 15 POSTMARK** for students who have completed at least two (2) semesters or quarters as defined by the university.

The scholarship recipient will be determined by the NAPNAP Foundation and notified within two (2) months of the application deadline. The recipient will be formally recognized at NAPNAP's Annual Conference.
