

# NAPNAP/NAPNAP Foundation Silent Auction Rules

In order to bid on any Silent Auction items, you must write your name, phone number, and bid on the bid sheet for the item in question. You may bid as many times as you wish as long as your bid is higher than the previous bidder.

**Preview: Items** will be posted in the registration area on the bulletin boards near the posters starting at 7:00 AM Wednesday.

**Auction: Starts Wednesday, March 28 at 11:45 AM and ends Friday, March 30 at 10:30 AM.** Each item will have a bid sheet on the table. To bid on an item, put your name and phone number on the highest available line with your bid amount in US dollars. The minimum bid (lowest price that is acceptable) for each item will be no less than \$5.00 unless marked otherwise on the bid sheet. Bids will be in whole dollar increments. Any bid involving an amount other than a whole dollar amount will be cancelled.

Bidding starts at 11:45 am, Wednesday, March 28, 2012.

- Items will be on display in the Exhibit Hall at the NAPNAP booth during all Exhibit Hall hours.
- Bid sheets will be available in the registration area by the posters during non-exhibit hours on Wednesday and Thursday to allow for additional bidding.
- The bidding will be continuous from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM on Wednesday and Thursday and from 7:00 AM until the auction closes on Friday, March 30 at 10:30 AM. Pickup by 3:00 PM.
- Bidders must legibly print their name/number and amount of the desired bid. First bids must meet the minimum bid value, and subsequent bids must increase by at least the set bid increment.
- Once bidding is closed, the bids will be entered in the Auction Computer and the winning bidder's name and winning basket will be posted in the registration area.
- Guaranteed Bid items will be removed once a guaranteed bid has been received.
- In the event of a dispute, the auction captains will have final authority and determine the final bidder.
- All sales are final.
- Bidders must make arrangements for pick-up or delivery of their items. Items on display the last day of the auction may be removed immediately after payment has been made.
- High bidders shall be prepared to pay for their items on Friday, March 30. Payment can be made in cash, check, or credit card (VISA, MasterCard, AMEX). All checks should be made out to the NAPNAP Foundation.

Bidders should read items carefully. Some items come with restrictions and clarifications are the responsibility of the bidders.

All items placed in the Silent Auction are sold "As Is", and NAPNAP nor the NAPNAP Foundation makes no expressed or implied warranties or representations of any kind or nature with respect to the items or services, and in no event shall NAPNAP or the NAPNAP Foundation be responsible for the accuracy of description, genuineness, authenticity, or condition of the item or service. No statement in the listing or made at the sale or in the bill of sale or invoice or elsewhere shall be deemed such a warranty or representation or assumption of liability. By their purchases, the buyers waive any liability against either NAPNAP, the NAPNAP Foundation, or the donors of the items or services, and neither NAPNAP, the NAPNAP Foundation, nor the donors are responsible for any personal injuries and damages to property that may result from the utilization of items or services sold.
