TRADITIONAL ROLE OF THE SCHOOL NURSE

- Often siloed away from school safety planning
- Consulted on certain, health related, points only
- Participate in crisis response



WHAT WAS MISSING IN THIS TRADITIONAL ROLE?

- Unique knowledge of student concerns and fears
- A student health-oriented voice on school safety committees
- A better understanding of how the school nurse fits into school public health concerns (even pre-COVID)
- An additional trained voice to support all safety planning efforts

Defining Moments



ACTS OF SCHOOL VIOLENCE

- Trauma interventions are now a part of the school toolkit
 - Stop the Bleed
 - Wound packing
- Additional training with law enforcement and school on providing care following a critical incident
 - Triage
 - Trauma Care



PUBLIC HEALTH EVENTS

- H1N1, COVID-19, Influenza, etc
- These events expanded the role of the school nurse as a public health practitioner.
 - Monitoring, reporting, contact tracing, mitigation strategies, and much more.
- Added the required skills of mediation and conflict management
 - As exclusions due to illness need to take place, high conflict can occur.

Rethinking the Role



COLLABORATIVE PLANNING

- Participate on building and corporation level school safety planning committees
- Attend or participate in county school safety commission meetings
- If able, attend the Indiana School Safety Specialist Academy; add additional safety skills to support your already unique knowledge.
- A nurse's knowledge, skills, and expertise can be applicable to the broad range of school safety planning.



EVACUATION AND RELOCATION

- Assisting with meeting the needs of students with disabilities or access or functional needs
- First aid kit development for go-bags, necessary equipment, first aid, sanitation, and more.



MITIGATION

- See something, say something.
 - How are nurses incorporated into threat training and reporting?
- Collaborative planning on responses to potential medical issues at school – routine and extraordinary.
- What hazards exist in your buildings? Are you prepared to assist?



RESPONSE

- The inclusion of multiple subject matter experts in collaborative planning allows for a more robust response.
- Working through planning, mitigation, and more will identify needs for responses.
