

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

LIE, I-495 or Northern State Parkway to the Cross Island Parkway South. From The Belt Parkway or Southern State Parkway take Cross Island Parkway North. Get off Cross Island Parkway at Hempstead Turnpike East. Travel East on Hempstead Turnpike approximately 2.5 miles to the Park Restaurant (across from the Hess station). Unloading is at ground level and parking is on the street, in the back and in the soccer field behind the bandstand.

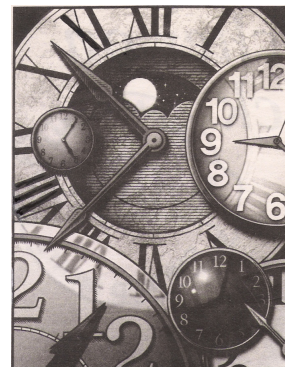

HENRY A. LUGRIN - WATCH INVENTOR

Jean Lugin Ferlesch, is the great-granddaughter of Henry A. Lugin, a Swiss watchmaker. Her research at the NAWCC library led to the discovery of other family members that were horologists in Switzerland. Growing up she knew the story of her great-grandfather, but no one seemed to know many details about him other than the fact that he had invented the stop watch.

By profession, Jean is a designer of home décor pillows, wall hangings and throws using the original patent drawings of her great-grandfather which are the basis of her watch embroideries. Her passion for embroidery rivaled her love of drawing. After seeing the book, "Sins and Needles" in which the author depicts prison life through hand embroidered images, Jean became inspired to express her own stories with thread. Her first series is an embroidered picture book of her own.

Family members who each remember a bit of this story have been connecting with Jean to share what they know and to appreciate Henry A Lugin, the Swiss horologist who came here in 1860 at the age of 20. He has brought them all together.
