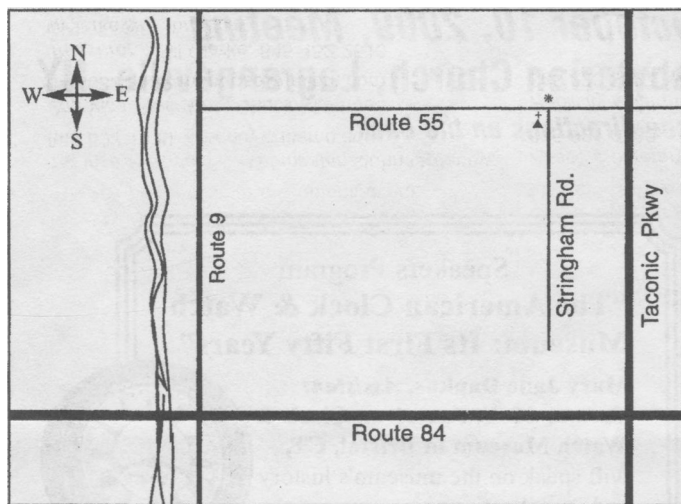

Directions:

From the Taconic State Parkway:

Take the Poughkeepsie/Route 55/West exit. Proceed WEST on Rte. 55 to the first traffic light (about .3 miles), at Stringham Road. You will see the large white church at that intersection on your left. Just past the church, make a left turn into the parking lot. There is an overflow parking lot just east of the church, entrance on Stringham Road. *The meeting room is on the west side of the Church, adjacent to the main parking lot.*

From US-9: At Poughkeepsie, take the 44/55 EAST exit. Proceed EAST on 44/55 for about 2 miles, where they split. Keep right and stay on Rte. 55. Continue EAST on Rte. 55 for about 5.5 miles. You will pass a McDonald's on your left, then a Getty station on your right. Immediately after the Getty station, there is a traffic light at the entrance of Arlington High School, which is on your left. Immediately after that traffic light you will find the church parking lot, on your right.

From I-84: Choose Taconic State Parkway or US 9, whichever is closer. Proceed about 9 miles north of the Taconic State Parkway, or about 12 miles north on US 9. Then follow the respective Directions above.
