Rules and Regulations

1. All persons participating in Chapter 121 auctions must be a paid up member in good standing with the National Association of Watch & Clock Collectors. **Guests may not bid.**
2. All items must be registered as soon as possible. Items should be batched wherever possible. Only horological related items will be accepted. Registration will start at 6:15PM and end at 7:15PM. Auction will start at 7:30PM sharp.
3. A \$2.00 registration fee will be required to obtain a bidding paddle.
4. During the auction a member may bid up their own items until the required reserve is met. Please bid your reserve early to save time.
5. Chapter 121 terms of sale are as follows:
 - A) All sales are final.
 - B) No warranties or guarantees are expressed or implied
 - C) All items are sold 'as is' and 'where is'.
 - D) Full payment must be made on sale day (or as otherwise arranged by buyer and seller). All monies being paid for auction transactions shall be strictly between the buyer and seller.
 - E) Chapter 121 assumes no responsibilities for lost, misplaced or stolen items.
 - F) **Absolutely no pre auctions sales on the premises.**
