Dr. Adeline Nyamathi's research focuses on providing culturally-sensitive intervention programs to homeless and drug-addicted populations at risk for HIV, tuberculosis and hepatitis A, B and C infections. She led the Fogarty AIDS International Training and Research Program at UCLA and was a mentor to scholars from India and Africa. She has received a number of National Institutes of Health external awards and as principal investigator of nine NIH Research Project Grants, has led teams of multidisciplinary investigators. During her long career she has disseminated more than 175 published works nationally and internationally in leading interdisciplinary journals. Dr. Nyamathi has received numerous honors and awards including the Gamma Tau Excellence in Research Award and Sigma Theta Tau Distinguished Lecturer Award.

Davida F. Kruger, MSN, APRN-BC, BC-ADM
Henry Ford Medical Center, Division of Endocrinology, Diabetes, Bone and Mineral Disorders

Davida Kruger received her master's in nursing from Wayne State University in 1982 and joined the Henry Ford Health System that same year. Board-certified by the American Nurses Association Credentialing Center in primary care and the American Association of Diabetes Educators in advanced diabetes management, she is past chair of the American Diabetes Association (ADA) Research Foundation; past president of Health Care and Education for the ADA; and past member of its Research Policy Committee. Kruger has published extensively and is editor-in-chief of the journal *Clinical Diabetes* and author of the book *The Diabetes Travel Guide*. She is part of the National Institutes of Health-funded Action to Control Cardiovascular Risk in Diabetes (ACCRD) trial and the ASPREE trial, an aspirin study to prevent brain deterioration in the elderly.
