Two Categories:

- (1) University Percussionist (Undergraduate or Graduate)
- (2) High School (Grades 9-12)

Eligibility:

- * Contestant must fall into either of the above categories.
- * Must be an active member of the *Percussive Arts Society*.
- * Winners must be able to perform on the TN Day of Percussion in Cookeville, TN, on Saturday, March 24, 2012.

Prizes:

- * **One winner from each category will be invited to perform at the Tennessee Day of Percussion on Saturday, March 24, 2012.**
- * **Both winners will receive an assortment of mallets, drumheads, and educational literature from assorted drum companies.**
- * **An award certificate signed by the judges and the TN Percussive Arts Society Executive Committee.**
- * **Each entry will receive written comments from two of the world's most respected percussion teachers:**
James Campbell (University of Kentucky) and
John Parks (Florida State University)
- * **Each contestant's name will appear in the TN Day of Percussion Program.**

How to Apply:

- (1) Record (video and audio) yourself playing two complete, unedited selections, not lasting longer than 15 minutes total. DVD preferred.
- (2) Complete the attached application.
- (3) Pay \$25 application fee (Make checks payable to "TN PAS").
