Reporting to the General Legal Counsel and Chief Freedom of Information and Privacy Officer with the expectation that you will become the subject matter expert, your responsibilities will include the development and implementation of an organization wide risk management plan, including, gauging organizational risk tolerance and developing alternative risk strategies. Aligning risk principals into strategic PHSA initiatives, you will work in collaboration with senior clinical and corporate leadership. The role will focus on identifying emergent risks, assessing policies and ensuring the organization is in compliance with regulations. Creating a clear integrated understanding of risk across PHSA, while driving the training and communication to guarantee PHSA Agencies and Corporate Services have an appropriate risk strategy in place.

The successful candidate will possess 5 years senior leadership experience with exposure to risk management and compliance initiatives. Interested individuals will have proven experience applying these principals within a large organization or corporation. Knowledge of corporate insurance issues and policies are necessary. A Masters Degree is preferred but all candidates with equivalent experience and training will be considered.
