Breezy Bend Golf Club

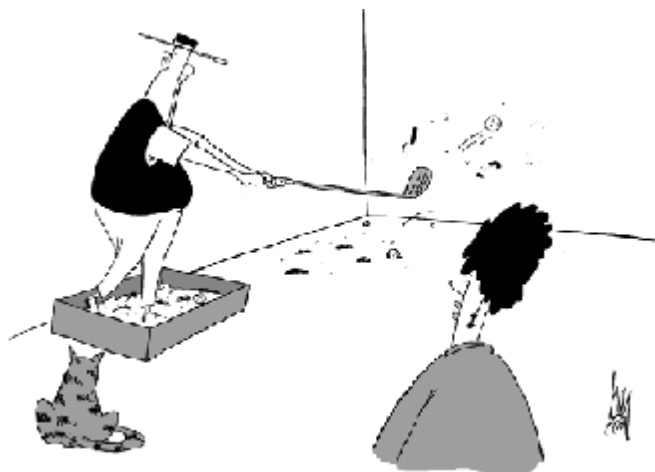
