He is the author of British Columbia Government's Enterprise Risk Management Guideline based on his experience refining risk assessment and implementation with departments, public corporations, commissions and agencies in British Columbia, Government of Yukon, and Government of Saskatchewan. He has presented his results at the RIMS ERM Summit, and published in Risk Management Magazine. Edward provided advice and risk facilitation services to the Vancouver Olympic games Organizing Committee, Camosun College, and a number of large government ministries.

CRM E Exam

The cost of the exam is \$300 US. Once participants complete the workshop they can register for the exam on the RIMS website. You must complete the workshop before you can register for the exam.

(Exam consists of 60 multiple choice questions and 4 short answer questions and is 90 minutes. There will be 4 testing windows during the year. The first will be at the end of March so participants can take the exam while the material is fresh in their minds.)
