- Serve as a resource for the student protégé when they have questions about the Industry
- Share your resources in the Industry, assist in business connections professional associations, networks, online resources recommended

- Support the student protégé as they advance towards their degrees, including types of courses to commence in preparation for their career path

Student Protégé
