“Climate Change and Ships: Increasing Energy Efficiency”
February 16-17, 2010

SNAME and the Marine Board of the National Academies are sponsoring a symposium, "Climate Change and Ships: Increasing Energy Efficiency." The symposium will be held on 16 & 17 February, 2010, at the Maritime Institute of Technology and Graduate Studies (MITAGS) in Linthicum, MD.

The symposium will have three tracks: Greenhouse Gas (GHG) and Energy Efficiency Design Index; GHG and Technical and Operational Measures to Increase Energy Efficiency (this includes port operations); and Maritime Economics and Market Based Mechanisms.

The fee for attending the meeting is \$125.00 for SNAME members, Marine Board and TRB panel members, and \$175.00 for non-members. The fee includes lunch and coffee breaks, and a final Proceedings including papers, presentations, and discussion summaries.
