

US Army 10th Sustainment Brigade: Ft. Eustis

Everyone is invited to attend the next SNAME dinner meeting on Jan. 20 at the Embassy Suites in Hampton. The speaker will be Lt. Col. Kenneth Williams, commander, 10th Transportation Battalion. The battalion has numerous watercraft that were an integral part of the Humanitarian Relief efforts in Haiti during the aftermath of the January earthquake.

Lieutenant Colonel Kenneth K. Williams enlisted in the United States Army on 25 September 1985, and upon completion of Basic and Advanced Individual Training, he was assigned to Fort McPherson, Georgia. During his enlisted career Lieutenant Colonel Williams served in several key leadership position including Squad Leader and Section Sergeant. In June 1995, he graduated from Army ROTC and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the Transportation Corps.

After graduation from the Transportation Basic Course, Lieutenant Colonel Williams was assigned as a Platoon Leader and later the Battalion Transportation officer in the 27th Main Support

Battalion, Fort Hood, Texas. Following his assignment at Fort Hood and graduation from the Officer's Advance Course; Lieutenant Colonel Williams was assigned as the Assistant Transportation Officer 3rd Infantry Division (M) followed by Company Command of the 416th Transportation Company, 24th Corps Support Group. Subsequent assignments include: Logistics Officer, Theater Special Operations Air Component Command, Kadena Airbase, Japan; Support Operations Officer and Battalion Executive Officer for 260th Corps Service Support Battalion; Division Transportation Officer 3rd Infantry Division and his current assignment as the Transportation Corps Lieutenant Colonel's Assignment Officer, Human Resources Command.

Lieutenant Colonel Williams' civilian education includes a Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration from Savannah State University, Masters in Logistics Management from Florida Institute of Technology and a Masters in National Security and Strategic Studies from the Naval War College.

His military education includes the Officer Basic and Advance Course, Combined Arms Services Staff School, Logistics Executive Development Course, and the Naval War College. Lieutenant Colonel Williams' awards include the Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (2nd Award), Joint Service Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal (5th Award), Army Achievement Medal (3rd Award), Air Force Achievement Medal, Army Good Conduct Medal (2nd Award), Iraqi Campaign Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, Most Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal and the Saudi and Kuwait Service Medals.


