- Justin Bush, SNAME-ASNE Student Representative
 - SNAME/ASNE Report – UPDATE on content and recommendations
 - Excellent liaison report
 - The Joint Strategic Alliance provides benefits for all members but Students are not taking advantage of the different branches/ opportunities available in the industry: awareness, participation and understanding of the committee
 - ASNE/SNAME Student Liaison be discontinued and shifted to the Joint Strategic Alliance Committee
 - Several chairs of panels expressed interest in Student involvement
 - Currently, liaison position is a voting member of the ASNE Council via bylaws. Joint Strategic Alliance liaison will hold the position until an ASNE SSC can be started/ created
 - Elections to be determined at ASNE Day

- Motion to have a Student representative and named Justin Bush until someone is elected/ interim Student should not be a problem
- In talking to Students, Students have little regard for what ASNE does, what ASNE is and hold little “regard”. BUT did not speak to ASNE-centric Students (at SSC, Universities, spoke to SNAME-centric Students)
- Bring up idea of local ASNE chapters financially supporting Student Sections – should have an answer by next telecom
- In line with structure of the Joint Strategic Alliance Committee
- NTH: Tremendously successful as ASNE is now thinking much more actively about Student involvement. Recommendation presents a new Student opportunity and takes advantage of the situation created
- JSAC Joint Sub-Committees: Education, Young Professionals, Mentoring
- Tony Dean expressed progress forward on JSAC is very slow and laborious and “boring” for Students. Doesn’t lend itself to active debate and discussion. Sub-Committees would offer more opportunity for input
- Always will be a voting Student representative on the ASNE Council although the Student may not be voted at a SNAME/ SSC meeting
- Will ASNE be committed to reaching out and supporting non ASNE-centric Student Sections?
- Student to possibly sit on Ways and Means Committee
- Change SSC bylaws in regards to Justin’s position on the ASNE Council/ JSAC – elected or appointed? Should be a past/present Student Section officer? Junior or Senior? Don’t limit pool of applicants
- Justin has found a structure
- Change bylaws of Communications Chair to fulfill duties of JSAC representative
- Elected position for ASNE/SNAME liaison but modified to serve on the JSAC and Sub-Committees and will work with the Student representative for the ASNE SSC
- NTH: During the elections, sell as “JSAC liaison” and highlight topics, such as YPs
