- Student Poster Display Competition/ Microsite Display Competition
 - Include with Student program
 - Research-type Poster versus Microsite
 - Overall poster ideas may be a better idea as Higher Logic is going thru upgrades and changes that may affect the existing microsites
 - Digital poster that can be uploaded to the microsite (each “poster” eligible for win)
 - In the past, posters are hard to travel
 - Possible “presentations” on Student’s research for people to attend – would it compete with the Student Paper’s Track? Targeted at a younger group of Students who are not ready to graduate or publish a paper
 - Might be difficult to target the “market”
 - Use as a networking opportunity
 - Send out eBlast as to who would be interested in presenting a poster/ short 5-minute talk/discussion to industry professionals on a research topics, paper topics or anything that they may be interested in pursuing. This would help to develop ideas, connect with the right members, etc.
 - Prizes: Cash and certificate
 - Themes?
