

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW APPLICANTS

Complete the attached application form providing all requested details. If you have questions or would like additional information, please contact your local Membership Chairman or SNAME's Member Services Department at 1-800-798-2188 or 1-201-798-4800 (outside North America) or fax to 201-798-4975. Portions of the form requiring particular attention are:

EMPLOYMENT INFORMATION

Please provide a detailed record of each position. This should include starting and ending dates, position title, name of firm, description of duties, total time in position. You may attach your CV JR biography.

REFERENCES

Be sure the proper number of references are provided and that these individuals meet the requirements as stated on the form for each grade of membership.

Those persons unable to provide the required references and signature shall submit the names of three non-member references and state the reason for this deviation. The Applications Committee shall consider this situation and act in their best judgment.

APPLICATION REVIEW

All applications for new members are reviewed by the Applications Committee, which meets on a monthly basis. You will be notified shortly after review. If accepted, you will receive a package of pertinent information including a membership card, membership certificate and other member benefit information.

REQUESTING CHANGE OF GRADE

Check the appropriate box at the top of the Application Form and complete all portions of the form.

New references are required for a change of grade. Be sure this portion is completed by the proper number of individuals and that these persons meet the requirements for grade as listed on the form.

All requests for change of membership grade are reviewed by the Applications Committee. You will be notified shortly after the review. If approved, you will receive a new membership card and membership certificate showing your new grade.

REINSTATEMENT

A Member who has resigned or whose membership has ceased for nonpayment of dues may be reinstated by the Applications Committee by any of the following:

1. By paying back dues from the year of severance of membership with reinstatement to take effect as of the year of original approval; or
2. By paying current year dues and a one-time administrative fee of \$50.00 with reinstatement to take effect as of the year of original approval adjusted for the years of broken membership. Members shall have the right of exercising this option one time during the life of their membership; or
3. By making a new application for membership with reinstatement to take effect as of the year of re-approval.

In any event, use the attached application in abbreviated form as appropriate. If membership has lapsed for two or more years, it will be necessary to complete the two sections identified as Education History and Employment Information.

GRADES OF MEMBERSHIP

Applications may be submitted for three grades of membership. Applications are reviewed by the applications committee on and the approved on the appropriate grade of membership. The requirement for each follows:

MEMBER

The grade of MEMBER may be accorded exclusively to persons having competence and important experience in naval architecture, marine engineering or another phase of engineering or science closely allied with the marine industry.

A candidate who is a graduate of a recognized technical institution or other institution satisfactory to the Society shall have had not less than five years of increasingly important engineering or scientific experience indicative of growth, competency and achievement, at least two of which shall have been in responsible charge of work.

A candidate possessing a Professional Engineer license or equivalent will be deemed to have given evidence of engineering or scientific experience indicative of growth, competency, and at least two years of which shall be in responsible charge of work.

Alternatively, a candidate who is not a graduate of a recognized technical institution shall have had not less than nine years of engineering or scientific experience indicative of growth, competency, and achievement, at least two of which shall have been in responsible charge of work.

The application form is to include training and experience that demonstrates that the candidate has been engaged in responsible capacity in the marine field and sets forth the grounds upon which the application for membership is based. The application shall be signed by three Members, who shall certify to their personal knowledge of the candidate and of the candidate's experience.

AFFILIATE

The grade of AFFILIATE may be accorded to persons whose pursuits, attainments, or practical experience qualify them to cooperate in the advancement of the objectives of the Society.

A candidate shall have had a sound education and shall have had not less than five years of increasingly important experience indicative of growth, competency, and achievement, at least two of which shall have been in responsible charge of work.

Alternatively, a candidate who is not a graduate of a recognized institution of higher learning shall have had no less than nine years of increasingly important experience indicative of growth, competency, and achievement, at least two of which shall have been in responsible charge of work.

A candidate for the grade of AFFILIATE shall submit a completed application form which shall be signed by three MEMBERS or AFFILIATES, who shall certify to their personal knowledge of the candidate and of the candidate's experience.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

The grade of ASSOCIATE MEMBER may be accorded to persons whose pursuits, attainments, education, or practical experience qualify them to cooperate in the advancement of the objectives of the Society, but who have not held a position of sufficient responsibility or lack the experience required for the grade of MEMBER or AFFILIATE.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS shall be eligible for the grade of MEMBER or AFFILIATE after fulfilling the necessary requirements.

A candidate for ASSOCIATE MEMBER shall submit a completed application form which shall be signed by two MEMBERS, AFFILIATES or ASSOCIATE MEMBERS, who shall certify to their personal knowledge of the candidate and the candidate's experience.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS may not hold office but may vote on all questions brought before the Society.

The grades of Fellow and Honorary Member are awarded upon nomination.



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
