About “Shipbuilding Around the World”

Dr. Thomas Lamb will present an overview of shipbuilding and the industry’s best practices, which are used by world class builders. He will give an assessment of the current shipbuilding situation including productivity and where the USA fits in.

Biography:

Dr. Thomas Lamb is retired from the University of Michigan where he was the Director of the Shipbuilding Research Lab and NAVSEA Ship Production Science Program, and an adjunct professor in the Department of Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering. He was born in Edinburgh, Scotland and moved to United States in 1966. Starting his career in 1950, he served a 5 year apprenticeship as a shipwright in HM Dockyard Rosyth. He received his Bachelor of Science from Kings College, Durham University in 1958, and an MBA from Tulane University in 1990. Dr. Lamb spent most of his career performing or managing ship design in many UK, European and US shipyards and design offices.

Dr. Lamb is a fellow of the Society of Naval Architects & Marine Engineers (SNAME), the Royal Institution of Naval Architects and the Institute of Marine Engineering Science and Technology, as well as a member of the American Society of Naval Engineers (ASNE). He is a Registered Professional Engineer in Washington and Wisconsin, a British Chartered Engineer and a European Engineer.

Dr. Lamb formed Innovative Marine Product Development, LLC in 1998 as a means to conduct consulting in ship design and shipbuilding and promote his design of an Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) and Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Marine Transport Containment System.
