Please join us for a presentation by Mr. Trey Austin on the "Joint High Speed Vessel" design and construction. This presentation will address the impact of Navy requirements on commercial design and production as well as discuss capabilities JHSV will provide for the joint services. The first of at least ten JHSVs was launched at Austal USA into Mobile Bay, Alabama on Sept. 12, 2011. The all-aluminum 35-knot catamaran displaces 2,500 tons, 338 feet long and 93 feet wide. It serves as a large and fast maritime truck with flexibility on modular vehicles and payloads.

Speaker Bio:

Mr. Trey Austin is presently the JHSV Ship Design Manager in the SEA 05D Design Office. Mr. Austin's holds a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from Old Dominion University. He is also a graduate of the Defense Acquisition University where he completed the Advanced Program Management course in 1999. He is DAWIA Level III certified in Acquisition Management and Systems Engineering and is a member of the Acquisition Professional Community (APC). Mr. Austin is well-known within the U.S. Naval design and engineering community having served as the SDM for the MPFF-CV, platform manager for the JCC(X) and life cycle manager for the LCC's.
