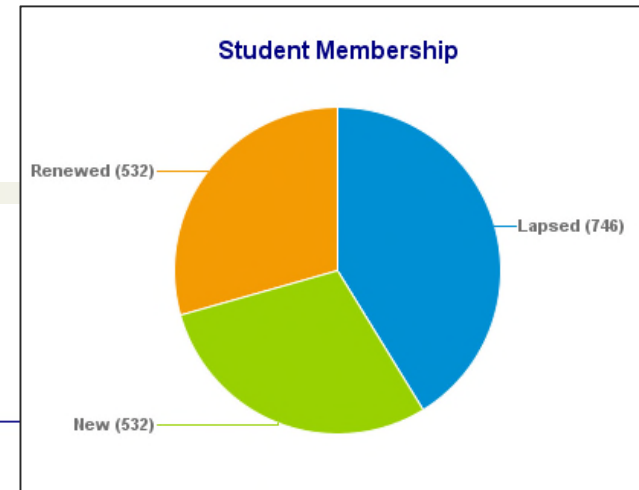

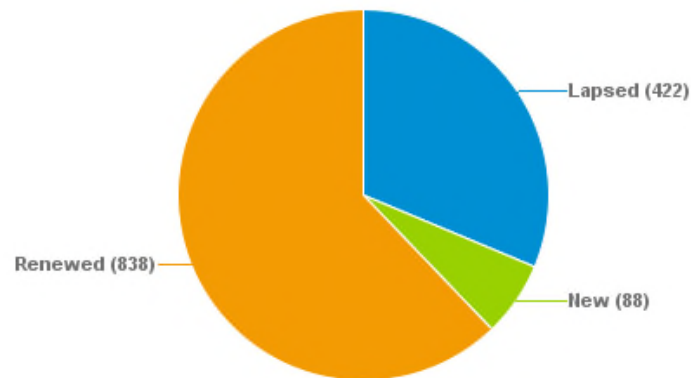

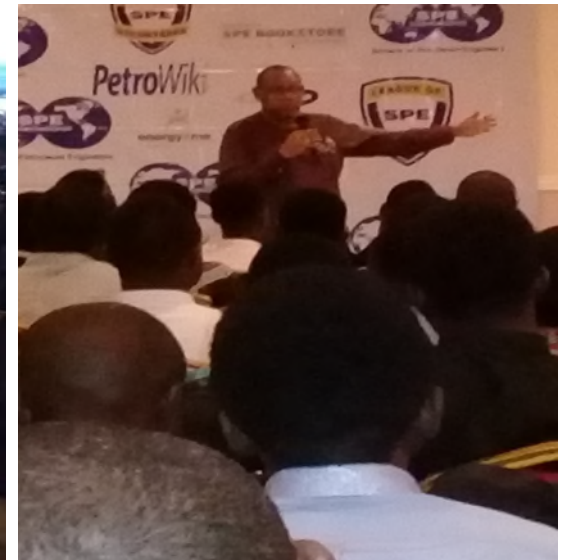


### Total Members by Year
