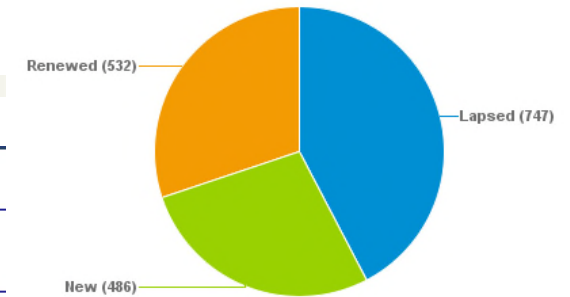

Student Membership



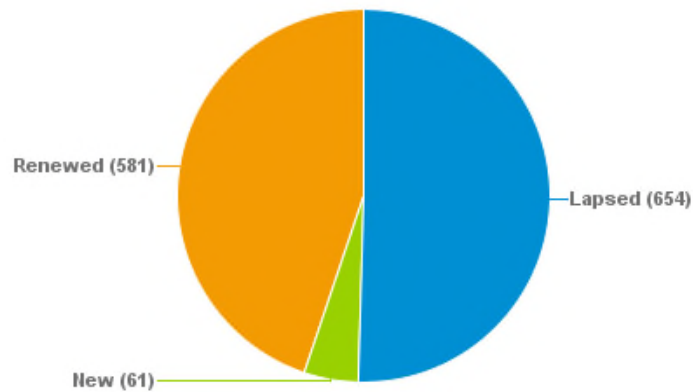

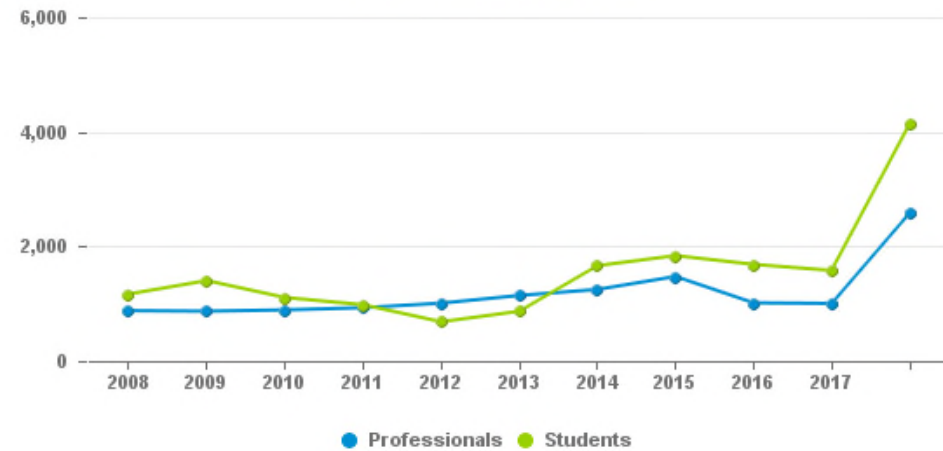
