Theta Tau has just joined 30+ other greek organizations in adopting **EverFi's** revoluationary

educational program <u>GreekLifeEdu</u>. EVERFI's online programs provide a comprehensive, year-round array of survey, education, and prevention resources tailored to meet the priorities/challenges of our Fraternity at the chapter or national level. GreekLifeEdu is an online program that addresses the critical **issues** of **alcohol awareness**, **sexual misconduct**, and **hazing** for incoming fraternity and sorority members. By leveraging trends and incorporating multiple evidence-based learning theories, GreekLifeEdu achieves behavior change objectives and helps members practice safer decision-making.

To begin best use of this program, all student members and pledges are expected to complete the GreekLifeEdu modules. A significant part of the module is simply survey questions to which your responses will remain anonymous (though response data will be aggregated by chapter and/or region). It is vitally important that we have your current members complete the program since it will enable us to create a baseline from which to measure future response results. In the future, it is highly likely that participation and completion of the GreekLifeEdu modules will be used in determining your chapter's liability insurance rates.

<u>Liability Insurance Program Description</u>

Adoption of Model New Member Education Program

Earlier this month, the Central Office emailed Invoices for General Liability, Directors and Officers, and Crime/Fidelity Insurance to each house corporation, chapter, and colony. Invoice amounts are based on a **3 year average of members measured each spring**. Liability Insurance **invoices** are **due by October 22**.

Your chapter also has the opportunity to recognize savings (10% discount) in the annual cost via adoption one of the New Member Education Models and notifying us via this form.

Housed chapters of Theta Tau that carry their property/fire insurance with the <u>JR Favor Company</u> should pay premiums in a timely manner directly to Denver. Do not allow your property/fire insurance to lapse due to non-payment – the risk is too great!

We pray that you and your family and friends have managed the recent hurricanes in the country, and hope that the remainder of the school year ahead is less traumatic!


The <u>Online Pledge Form</u> expedites the upload of prospective member information and is designed to fulfill compliance with Theta Tau laws. It must be **completed at the very start of pledging**. The Pledge Form has been modified to **restored functionality** based on the user's selection of school/college. Please note that the information keyed by the user is uploaded to our CRM; therefore, do **not** use "pledge names" for nickname field.

Membership Status Change and Co-op Reports were due September 15 to ensure that each chapter's Fall Semiannual Dues Invoice is as accurate as possible. Use the Online NCR

form process found here. If you have not filed reports due 9/15 yet, **do so now.**

Alternatively to the NCR, the live **Chapter Management Tool** as it includes membership info, form submissions, and the annual report to try and reduce confusion. Your chapter officers should have received a Login & Password to access this google doc system. If not, please contact your Regional Director for details. <u>FAO</u> for this management tool may be of assistance to you. (While this system is "live," it does not process your submissions/filings in real time; instead, the data reported is batched, standardized, reviewed, and then approved/uploaded.)

The New Member Education Manuals linked above contain very detailed instruction, information, checklists, and materials needed to conduct a well-planned education period. Each Manual is divided into three parts: Instructors Manual, Handouts, and Pledge Workbook. Your chapter is encouraged to use these Manuals now. The 2017 Membership Manual (the "redbook") has been inordinately delayed by a variety of causes. Please have current members loan their manuals to those currently pledging if necessary.) Our apologies that it may not be available until the end of the year.

SEMIANNUAL DUES

Dues Invoices and completed Dues Lists for each chapter and colony will be emailed in late October to Regents and Treasurers. **Chapter Dues are payable at \$90 each with a \$10 discount for payments sent by November 1.** This represents the first increase in National Dues since 1997 (20! years). Colony Dues remain \$30/person.
