#### Concerning Act 48 Hours

Any AAFCS/PAFCS Member in good standing may access educational programs through AAFCS and PAFCS. These professional development programs in the form of webinars, workshops, and conferences are all eligible for Act 48 hours reported through PAFCS. For AAFCS events (webinars live and archived, workshops, conferences), if there is a PDU certificate issued, PAFCS will report those as Act 48 hours. Simply send the title and a copy of the PDU certificate to request an evaluation from the Professional Development Chair plhetrick2@gmail.com.

If there are other programs you have attended that "add to or reinforce the Family and Consumer Sciences Body of Knowledge," consider contacting the Professional Development Chair (plhetrick2@gmail.com) for Act 48 hours.

Several organizations record the Act 48 hours for you. Here are a few suggestions:

- 1. The programs from the Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia. Consider joining the Federal Reserve's mailing list. There is a free session, *Learning, Earning, and Investing*, on December 6 from 5-8:30 PM at the Federal Reserve Bank in Philadelphia. Presented by Todd Zartman, these workshops are phenomenal.
- 2. Programs from Making Cents are presented virtually by Hilary Hunt. Consider signing onto her <u>mailing list</u> to remain informed about financial education programs.

#### Concerning Certification

AAFCS offers several certification options that help identify you as the expert. A test is required and once achieved you would be required to achieve 75 professional development hours in your area over 3 years and pay a maintenance fee. Any course FCS-specific is eligible for Act 48 hours and can be self-reported as PDUs. The list of workshops that qualify (including doing professional presentations) is extensive.

Tests are offered online, at specific testing sites, at the AAFCS Conference, AAFCS Leadership training, and at the PAFCS conference in April at a reduced price from the other options. You may take one of three tests offered through AAFCS and must register online with AAFCS for that test before our conference in April. Tests offered include CFCS Certified in FCS, CNWE Certified Nutrition and Wellness Educator, and CPFFE Certified Personal and Family Financial Educator.
