Student Performance and Achievement

The accredited family and consumer sciences units are required to routinely report - to the public - accurate information about student performance and achievement. Provide the information, format and frequency of routinely reporting to the public reliable information about student performance and achievement. Data regarding number of graduates from the Unit, retention rates, graduation rates, and performance on national exam for the last 3 years are required. Units are encouraged to provide other data that is routinely collected and reported on job placement rates, post-baccalaureate internships placements, performance of graduates on national examinations, etc.
