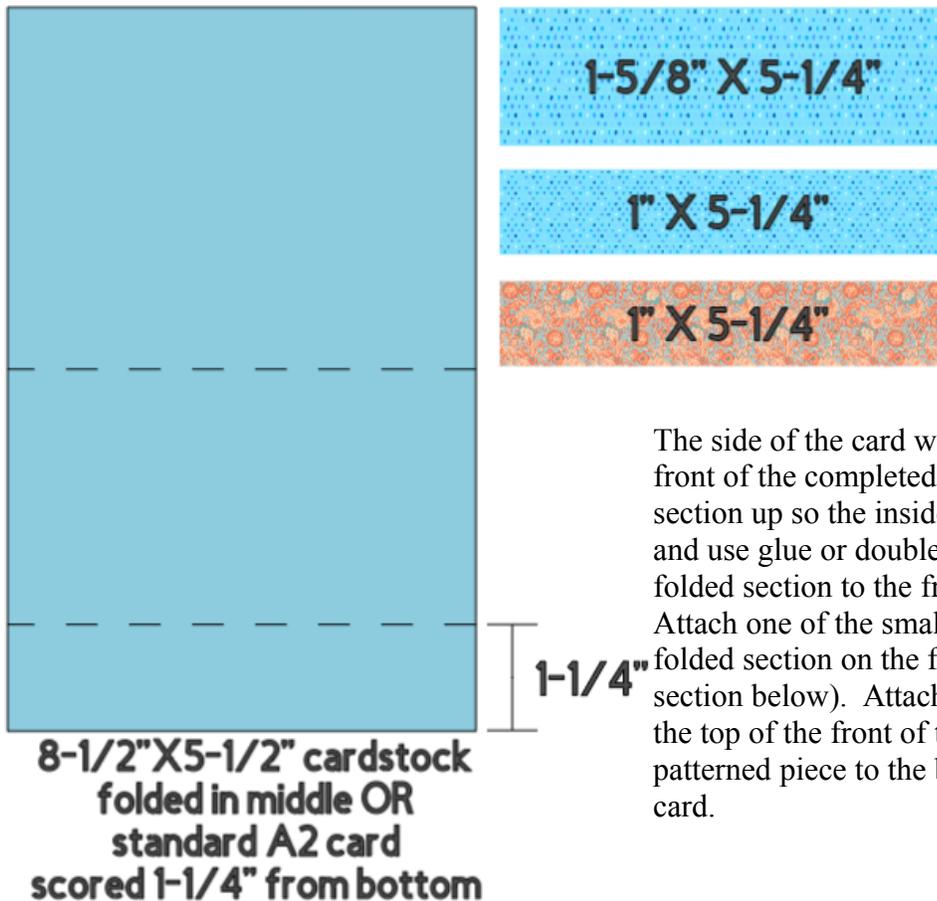


Four Fun Fold Cards

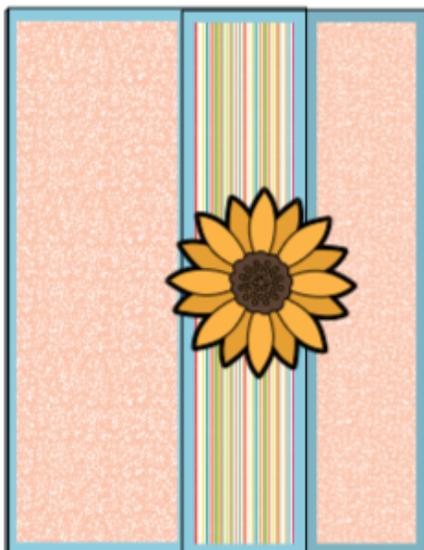
#1

Cut a 8-1/2" X 5-1/2" piece of cardstock or get a standard A2 card. Score the card 1-1/4" from the bottom. Cut a 1-5/8" X 5-1/4" and two 1" X 5-1/4" pieces of patterned paper.

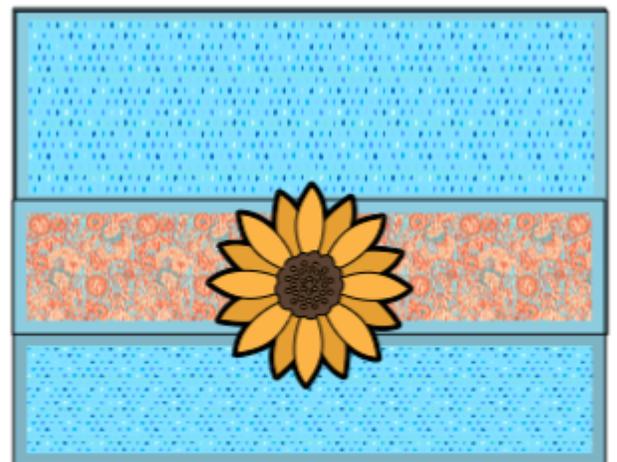


The side of the card with the score line will be the front of the completed card. Fold the scored section up so the inside of the card can be seen and use glue or double-sided tape to attach the folded section to the front of the card.

Attach one of the smaller patterned pieces to the folded section on the front of the card (pink section below). Attach the largest pattern piece to the top of the front of the card and the last patterned piece to the bottom of the inside of the card.

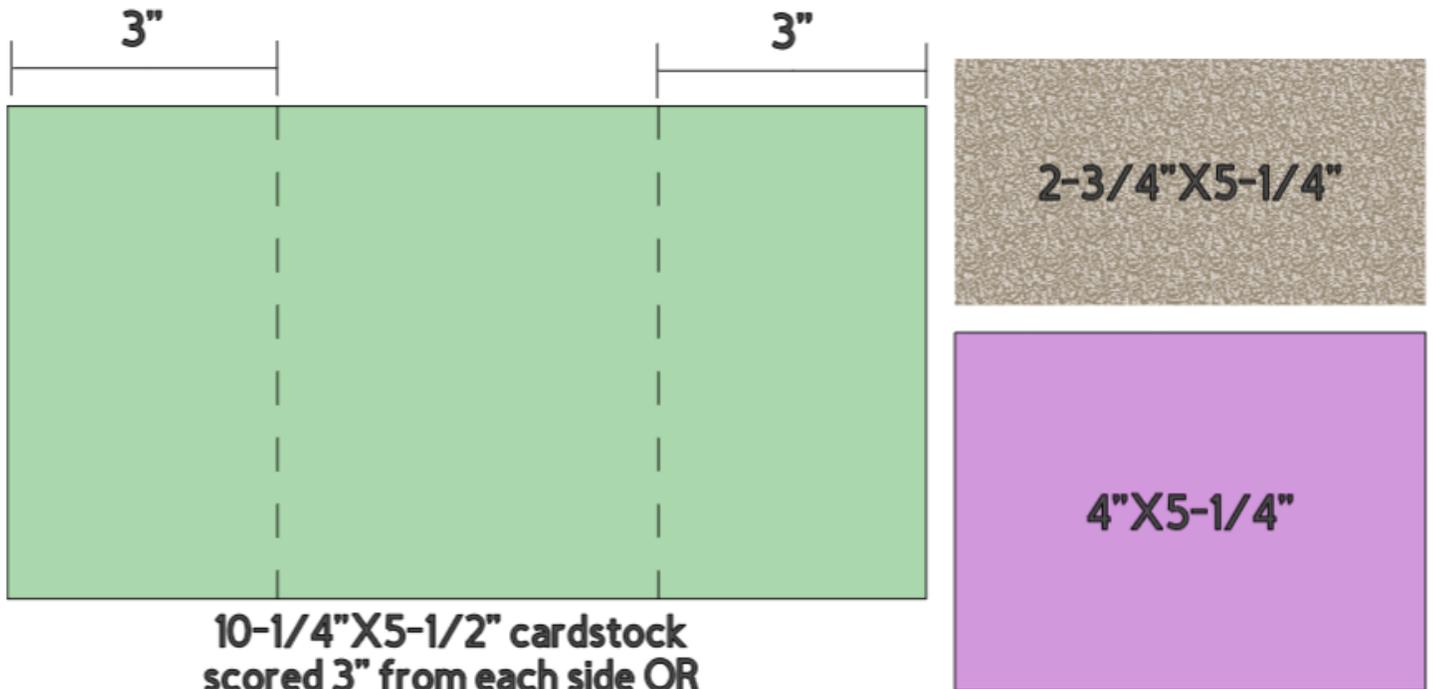


Add decorations as desired and sentiment to inside of card.
Card can be horizontal or vertical.
Card will fit into a standard A2 envelope (4-3/8" X 5-3/4").



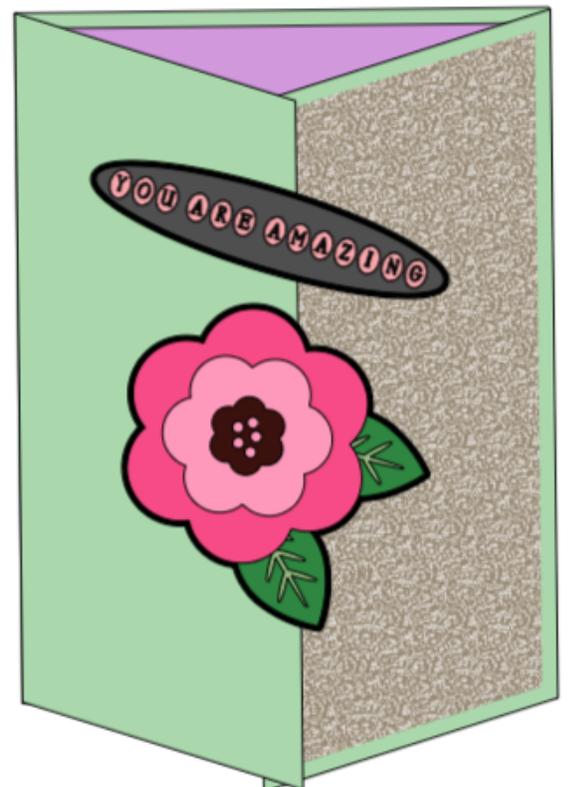
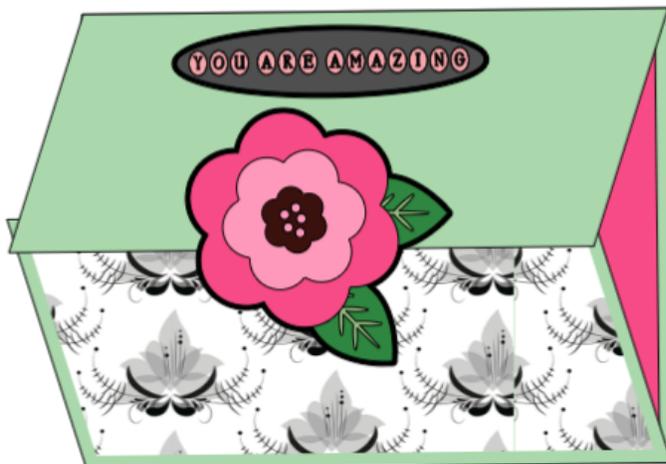
#2

Cut a 10-1/4"X5-1/2" piece of cardstock and score 3" from each end or glue two standard A2 cards together so you have a tri-fold card, then cut 1-1/4" off each end (keep these left over bits for card #4). Either way you end up with the same as the green below. Cut a 2-3/4"X5-1/4" piece of patterned paper and a 4"X5-1/4" piece of coordinating solid paper.



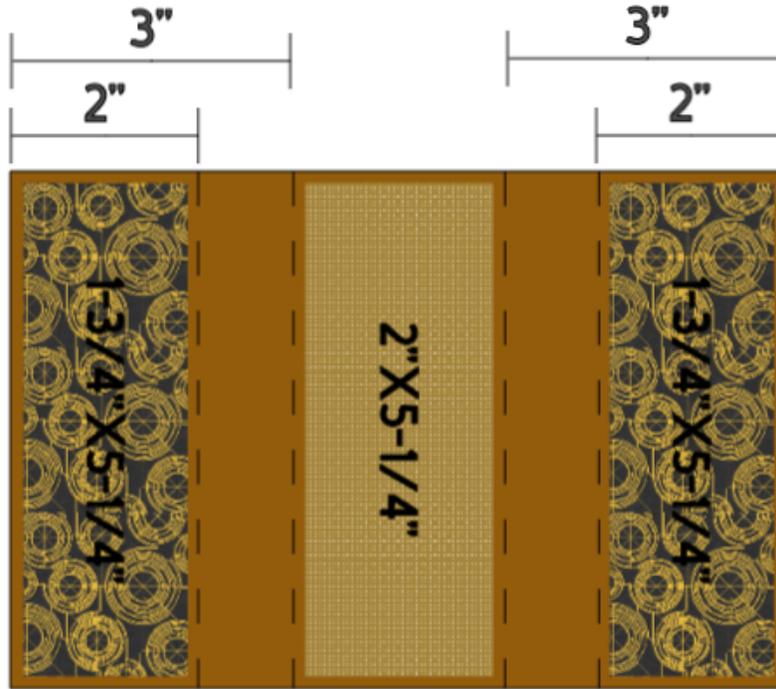
**10-1/4"X5-1/2" cardstock
scored 3" from each side OR
two standard A2 cards
glued together
with 1-1/4" cut off each side**

Glue the patterned paper to the outside of the right fold and the solid paper to the inside of the card.
Add decorations as desired and sentiment to inside of card.
Card can be horizontal or vertical.
Card will fit into a standard A2 envelope (4-3/8"X5-3/4").



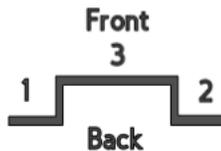
#3

Cut an 8-1/4"X5-1/2" piece of cardstock and score 2" and 3" from each end. Cut a 2"X5-1/4" piece of patterned paper and two 1-3/4"X5-1/4" pieces of patterned paper.



8-1/4"X5-1/2" cardstock
scored 2" and 3" from each side

Fold the 2" scored sections up and the 3" scored sections down. Your card should form this shape:



Place one of the smaller patterned pieces on the front side of section 1 and the other smaller piece on the front side of section 2. Place the larger piece on the front of section 3. Other panels can be decorated, but this will add weight if mailing.

Add decorations as desired and sentiment to the back of the card.

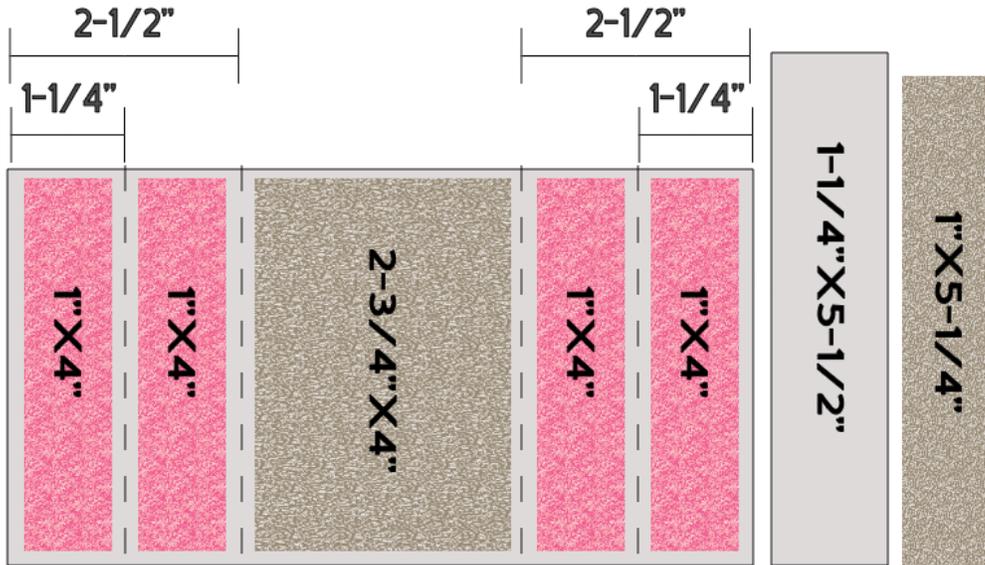
Card will fit into a standard A2 envelope (4-3/8"X5-3/4") when pressed flat.

Card stands on its own when not flat.



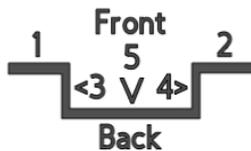
#4

Cut an 8"X4-1/4" piece of cardstock and score 1-1/4" and 2-1/2" from each end. Cut a 2-3/4"X4" piece, 1"X5-1/4" piece and four 1"X4" pieces of patterned paper. Also, cut a 1-1/4"X5-1/2" piece of cardstock which will be the "bridge" of this card.



**8"X4-1/4" cardstock
scored 1-1/4" and 2-1/2" from each side**

Fold the 1-1/4" scored sections up and the 2-1/2" scored sections down. Your card should form this shape:



Place one of the smaller patterned pieces on the front side of each section 1, 2, 3 and 4. The largest patterned piece should be attached to the front side of section 5. The bridge piece should be glued from the left edge of side 1 to the right edge of side 2. It helps to glue while card to pressed flat. The bridge should be aligned with the bottom of the card. Glue the remaining pattern piece to the bridge. Panels on the back of the card can be decorated, but this will add weight if mailing.



Add decorations as desired and sentiment to the back of the card. Card will fit into a standard A2 envelope (4-3/8"X5-3/4") when pressed flat. Card stands on its own when not flat.
