- Resolution: 300 DPI
- Background: Transparent

2. Top 3 Finalists Selected

Each finalist’s artwork will be printed as a poster and displayed at the 2026 AAFCS Annual Conference.

3. Vote at Conference

4. Winning Design Announced

The design with the most votes becomes the official AAFCS t-shirt and will be announced during the closing celebrations of the Annual Conference.
