


Foundation Increases Member Benefits to \$20,000+ Annually

From originally offering one \$300 undergraduate scholarship, fast-forward to the current benefits the Foundation makes available to WAFCS members. The following list represents increased award amounts, as well as new awards, thanks to the Mary Kaye Merwin bequest.

Details for applying for all member benefits can be found on the WAFCS website. To promote the concept that "Membership has its Benefits!" you must be a current AAFCS/WAFCS member to be eligible and preference for the conference travelships will be given to first-time attendees and/or those in the early years of their professional careers.

For Student/Pre-professional Members:

- \$750 Undergraduate Scholarship
- \$1250 Graduate Scholarship
- \$125 Travelship (up to 10) to WAFCS Annual Conference
- \$300 Travelship (up to 3) to AAFCS Annual Conference
- \$300 for a WAFCS member serving on the AAFCS Student Unit Leadership team to attend the AAFCS Leadership Summit

For Professional Members:

- \$100 Reimbursement incentive to become fully certified in any one of the AAFCS-sponsored certifications
- \$1500 Professional Project/Research Grant offered twice annually with deadline dates of Feb. 15 and Sept. 15
- \$250 Stipend (up to 5) to attend WAFCS Annual Conference
- \$750 Travelship (up to 3) to AAFCS Annual Conference
- \$750 Travelship for a member of the WAFCS Annual Conference Planning Committee to attend the AAFCS Annual Conference prior to the state conference for which they are responsible
- \$750 Travelship to WAFCS Award Recipients (Teacher of the Year, Leader, New Achiever)
