## Quick Guide: Test Site Approval



Test Sites are defined by the structure or level of testing and data reporting needed. (e.g., institution level, department/campus level, or instructor/teacher level). Test sites are NOT defined by the actual physical testing location or facility. The assessment portal and data results will be grouped by the level at which the test site is defined.

Navigate to AAFCS Website (www.aafcs.org)
Click on blue "Pre-PAC" button to access the Pre-PAC Management System
Click on "1 - Apply to be a Testing Site"
Complete the Online Test Site Application Form  Provide name and contact information for person completing the application.  Choose "Standard Application" or "Multi-Site Application
