Preference will be given to those whose work directly relates to Latin American geographies.

To apply, please submit a short narrative (maximum 400 words) that explains how you meet the eligibility criteria and contextualizes your conference participation within current career stage, as well as a statement of any other funding available for the 2026 AAG meeting. Candidates must be current members of LASG to apply, and please send proof of conference registration with the application.

Please submit applications via e-mail to Taylor Tappan (<u>taylor.tappan@uta.edu</u>) no later than **March 1st, 2026, by 11:59 pm Eastern Time**.

A selection committee will review all submissions and make a recommendation to the Committee Chair. Awardees will be notified by mid-March 2026. The winning submission will be announced and recognized at the 2026 LASG business meeting during the AAG meeting.
