As indicated in the minutes, we ought to put the Steering Committee to work now. Following is a list of charges. Please let me know what area(s) you would like to work on. After I gather all four responses I shall send out the result and details. You are welcome to participate in more than one area. I shall take care of areas in which no one shows interest (although I sincerely hope that this will not be true).

1. Gathering information, e.g. bylaws, charters, and etc. of organizations of similar nature, and distributing them to committee members for reference purpose.
2. Studying the possible types of organizations for our Group, including our relationship with AALL, the AALL Minority Committee, and the possibility of becoming a SIS.
3. Studying and recommending on the internal structure of the Group, including its official name, list of officers, and the voting procedures.
4. Studying and recommending on the possibility of a monetary due.
5. Drafting the proposed bylaw.

During our organizational meeting we agreed to send the first draft proposal to people on our mailing list no later than February, 1988. If we want to stick to this promise we should come up with some ideas to be distributed among the Committee members in October. After discussion we can draw our preliminary conclusion by the end of January to be mailed in February.

Let me know if you have any kind of suggestion. I would like to hear from you before next month. I am sure that together we will come up with something meaningful.
